## From the Moderator's Desk

### The Resurrection

"Do not be afraid! I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said" (Matt. 28:5-6). That message of the angel is the basic message of Easter. We are here because the first witnesses were filled with joy. They told others the good news and those people told others until someone in our day invited you.

Do you believe? Every Easter during Mass after the homily we renew our baptismal promises. "Do you believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?" "Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, suffered death and was buried, rose again from the dead and is seated at the right hand of the Father?" "Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?" In baptism we renounced Satan and his works and promised to serve God in the holy Catholic Church.

Why is believing in Christ important? We are acknowledging that we needed a Savior. Because of sin we have a ruptured relationship with God. That is a relationship that we are incapable of fixing by our own merits. Eternal life is not something that we earn, it is a gift. It is a gift that requires something on our part. I like a commentary of St. John Fisher in which he explained it this way:

*All who have embarked on true contrition and penance for the sins they have committed, and are firmly resolved not to commit sins again for the future but to persevere constantly in that pursuit of virtues which they have now begun, all these become sharers in this holy and eternal sacrifice.*

The resolution does not mean that we are perfect. It does mean that as Christians we are called to act as disciples in this world and thereby act differently. After we answer the above questions at liturgy we might also ask ourselves the question whether those around us know that we are Christian by our behavior or does our behavior scandalize. Sharers in Christ's sacrifice means that we are working with him and working with him in everything that we do. As I stated in the beginning of this article, somebody, most likely many people have been instrumental in telling you about Jesus. Our salvation is tied to us as a disciple communicating that faith to others as well.

I pray that you will have a wonderful Easter with your family. The Easter season lasts for 50 days. I hope that these will be days in which you have moments to contemplate what Jesus has won by his victory over death and how his Resurrection changes everything. Please remember to pray for me.



## THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited using ordinary Rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska* and followed by a closing prayer.

Praying the Divine Mercy chaplet at the three o'clock hour has become common practice, however it can be prayed at any time of the day or night, and our Lord made it clear that He desires our attention at that hour to whatever degree our duties allow.

### How to Recite the Chaplet

#### 1. Make the Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### 2. Opening Prayer

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!

#### 3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

#### 4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.

#### 5. The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

#### 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

#### 7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### 8. Repeat for the remaining decades


Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

#### 9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)


Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### 10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

**The Chaplet of Divine Mercy** is a prayer of intercession prayed on ordinary rosary beads in as little as ten minutes, yet its prayerful recitation comes with a plethora of graces and promises. Jesus instructed Saint Faustina, "My daughter, encourage souls to say the

chaplet which I have given you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet." (Diary, 1541) Join us to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet next weekend.
