

DID YOU KNOW...


...that **our liturgical Christmas season** begins with the vigil Masses on Christmas Eve?

...that **our Christmas season** concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord which, this year, is Sunday, January 9?

...that, in the Catholic dioceses of the United States, the Epiphany of the Lord (Three Kings' Day) is moved to the Sunday after January 6 - instead of being celebrated on January 6, as was once the tradition?

... that, each year, the Baptism of the Lord falls on the Sunday after Epiphany?

...that the word "epiphany" takes its meaning from the Greek word *epiphania*, meaning "manifestation?"

Saint Sebastian's International Pilgrim Center



Saint Sebastian: Saint Sebastian, a native of Milan, was an officer in Diocletian's imperial guard. Upon the orders of the emperor, he was tied to a post and shot with arrows due to his acts in favor of Christians. He is the patron of athletes and widely believed as a protector against the plague.

Saint Andrew's Basilica - Saint Sebastian's International Shrine: The church is located in Arthunkal, Kerala, India and is the largest shrine of Saint Sebastian in the world. The church was constructed in the 16th century.

The grand annual feast of Saint Sebastian, also known as *Arthunkal Perunnal*, is celebrated in January for 18 days. A ceremonial procession on the 20th of January to the beach attracts a huge crowd of pilgrims. Thousands of Hindu pilgrims, who return from Sabarimala temple, pay their homage to the saint and remove their bead chains at the altar, marking the end of their pilgrimage. This custom of Hindus visiting the church dates back to 1560, when the local Hindus helped in construction of the church



church dates back to 1560, when the local Hindus helped in construction of the church and is a shining example of religious harmony.



Miracles: In 680 AD, there was a severe epidemic of smallpox in Rome. People took the arrow that hit on the forehead of the saint in procession around the city, and there was a miraculous healing. Following this great incident, a statue of Saint Sebastian was brought to India as part of a vow. In January of 1647, the statue was taken festively in procession, and there was a miraculous healing of the sick. Witnessing this miracle, the non-Christians of Arthunkal, embraced Christianity.

Cultural Influence: A great part of devotees to the church consists of those who have recovered from serious illness and of others who have escaped grave accidents. To show their gratitude, they crawl on their knees from the beach to the church. People also take an arrow on a plate from the chapel to the church as a vow.




