DID YOU KNOW...

...that we have a font in the church, near the Baptismal Font, filled with holy water?

...that holy water is used for blessings for three reasons: as a sign of repentance of sin, for protection from evil, and as a reminder of our Baptism?*

...that you are welcome to bring a small container to fill with water from the font to use in your home?

...that the repentance of sin symbolized in the washing with water is reflected in Psalm 50: "...Thoroughly wash me from my guilt and of my sin cleanse me. Cleanse me of sin with hyssop that I may be purified; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow" (3-4, 9). (Hyssop is a small bush used for sprinkling water)?*

...that Saint John the Baptizer called all to conversion using a ritual washing of water to signify the repentance of sin and purification?*

...that holy water is just one of the many sacraments that we are blessed with in the Catholic Church to help bring and keep us closer to God?

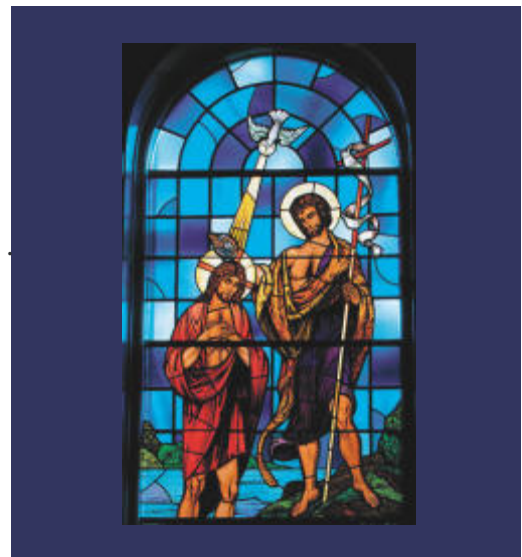


MEN'S FELLOWSHIP AT CHRIST, OUR LIGHT!

Here are some thought starters from this Sunday's Readings (1/9/22). The Gospel (Lk 3: 15,16,21, 22) describes Jesus' baptism and the response of God to Him. How would you feel if you heard God saying to you, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased"? ... Realizing that, since you are in Christ, God IS saying this to you, how do you respond?

Here is a thought starter using next week's Readings (1/16/22). The First Reading (Is 62:1-5) begins, "for Zion's sake I will not be silent." This reminds me of the statement from the movie "The Patriot," when the main character was told, "You have done nothing for which you should be ashamed." To which he replied, "I have done nothing. And for that I am ashamed." What incident or circumstances in your life are you prompted to "not be silent" any longer? How is the Spirit prompting you to take action?
