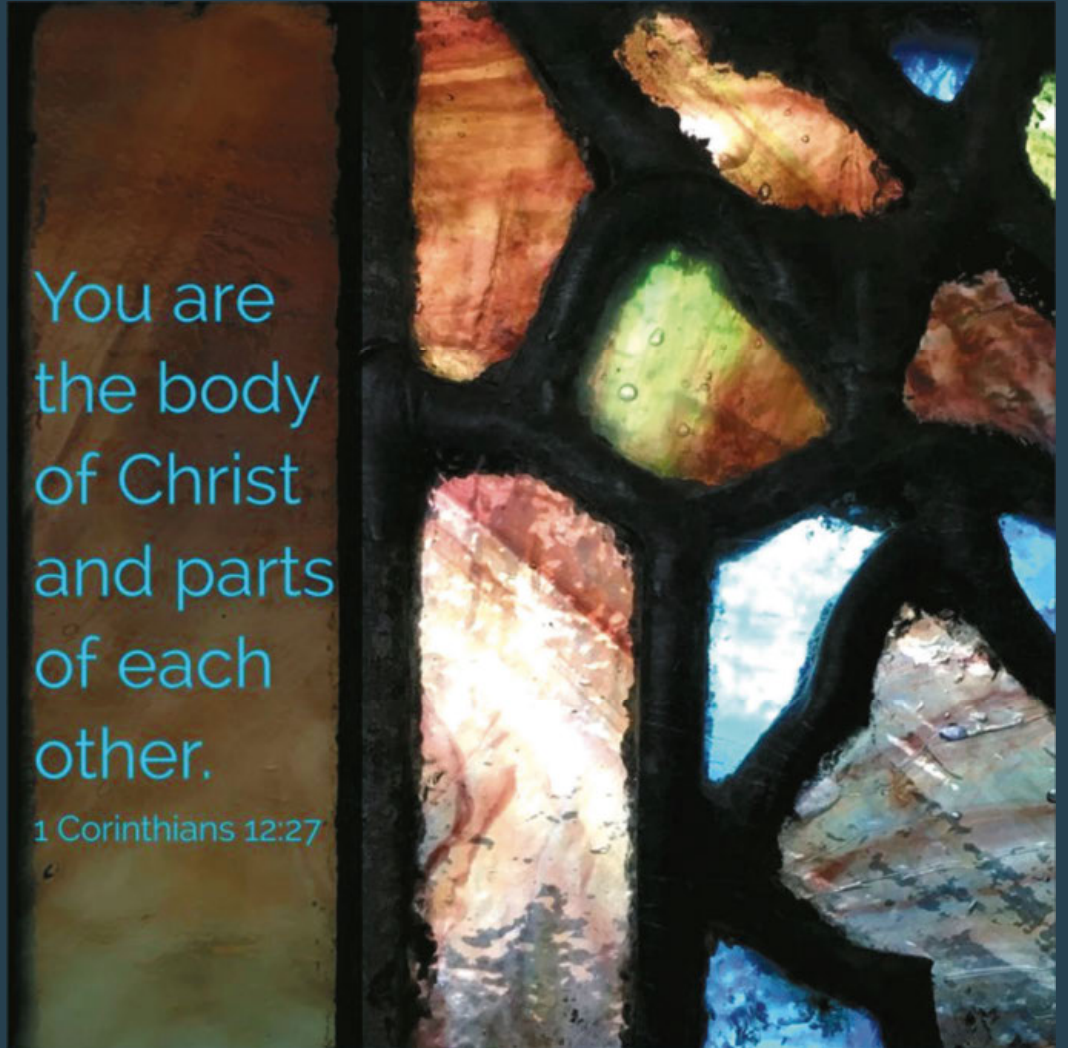

**MEN'S FELLOWSHIP AT
CHRIST, OUR LIGHT!**

Here is a thought starter from this Sunday's Readings (1/23/22). The Gospel (Lk 1: 1-4 4:14-21) has been called Jesus' 'Mission Statement': "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord." Since we want to be like Jesus, it should be our Mission Statement as well. How could you fulfill this ...? Might it help to think of someone who is discouraged, depressed, homebound, lonely ...?

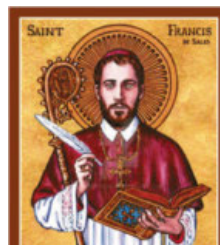

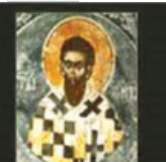
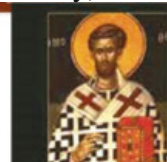

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS



SUNDAY PRESCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN CLASSES

Preschool and Kindergarten children are invited to attend the **11 AM** session on Sundays at Christ, Our Light! (**ages 3-6**). The class has been in session since mid-November and is held in Room 3. Children may join the group at any time – each week's lesson is based on the Gospel Reading for that Sunday. There is prayer, coloring, music, a Gospel Reading and discussion, activities, and crafts for the duration of the 11 AM Mass. Parents will need to fill out a registration form, and children must be masked. There is no charge. They may enter the classroom at 10:50. If they arrive before the catechist, a parent should wait with the child until the teacher arrives. Attendance has been low, possibly because of the COVID numbers. If you are watching from home or not comfortable attending yet, **there are extra Gospel worksheets available each week on the shelf next to the Religious Education Office.** Directions are attached so that parents may follow the lesson plan. The Pflaum Gospel Weeklies are weekly circulars that explore the Gospel Reading and other faith concepts with children of this age group. Please feel free to pick up for your children. These are also age-appropriate for first and second graders. A picture above shows the display. We welcome you to participate. A new calendar will be published for preschool the beginning of February.

LITURGY OF THE WORD FOR CHILDREN (LWC).

Liturgy of the Word for Children (LWC) is a second Sunday program for children in grades 1-6 that meets in Classrooms 5 & 6. In this class, children are called out of Mass before the First Reading by the catechist. They go to the classrooms and hear the Gospel in an easier format that they understand and discuss. A worksheet or activity sheet based on the Sunday Gospel is also available. Children return to Mass at the Offertory. **THIS CLASS HAS BEEN TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED.** Classes will resume at a later date. Stay tuned.

FIRST EUCHARIST MEETING – MONDAY, JANUARY 31

A mandatory meeting for First Eucharist parents will be held on **Monday, January 31, at 5:30 PM** in the church. Father Don will address parents about the sacrament and their role in preparing their children. Materials will be distributed following Father's discussion. This meeting is for parents only – children will be attending their formation classes.

The message clearly states that the Church is a home for everyone. Yes it is!

Vatican launches #IamChurch for people with disabilities

In his message for the United Nations' International Day of Persons with Disabilities, Pope Francis said that not tending to the spiritual needs of the disabled is "the worst form of discrimination"...and made it clear that baptism makes all men and women "full-fledged" members of the Church "so that all of us, without exclusion or discrimination, can say: 'I am the Church!'" he wrote. "The Church is truly your home, the pope told people with disabilities. "We, all of us together, are the Church, because Jesus chose to be our friend."...the Vatican's Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life launched a new campaign, #IamChurch, that shares the stories of how Catholics with disabilities are helping the Church. "We are convinced that if we are able to listen attentively to the voices of our sisters and brothers with disabilities, the ecclesial community will come out truly enriched," said Gabriella Gambino, undersecretary of the dicastery.
