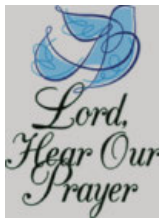

LENTEN GIVING WRAP-UP

Lenten Giving in Religious Education's Monday night program was threefold this Lent. The children in grades 1-4 raised \$1093.16 for CRS Rice Bowls. Seventh and eighth graders completed approximately 25 blankets for the Fleece & Thank You organization that provides bright-colored blankets to children in the hospital with an inspirational video message embedded into it. Our fifth and sixth graders purchased and packed items for hygiene or "Blessing Bags" for Matchan, a branch of Saint Vincent de Paul. We are proud of all their efforts and enthusiasm for these projects. They served the Lord well.

Matchan Nutrition Center is a Catholic organization and a USDA-approved nutrition center affiliated with Saint Vincent de Paul and located in downtown Pontiac. Their mission is to assist and feed the hungry in our community by serving hot, well-balanced meals free of charge, providing free groceries in the Matchan Marketplace, and connecting people with resources, materials, and assistance to those in need.
