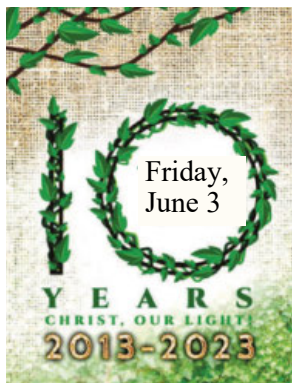
CELEBRATING OUR TEN YEARS AS CHRIST, OUR LIGHT!
