MEN'S FELLOWSHIP AT CHRIST, OUR LIGHT!

Here is a question from this Sunday's readings (7/16/23). The Responsorial Psalm (Ps 65:10-14) describes God watering the land. Rain isn't always gentle ... In fact, it can sometimes pound hardened ground and soften it. When has God's Word "softened" your heart and maybe changed your way of thinking or behaving?

Here's a question using next week's Scriptures (7/23/23). The Second Reading (Rom 8:26-27) says, "The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings. And the One who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because He intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will." 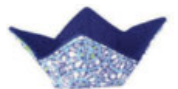

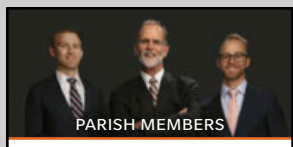


Isaiah 55:10-11
