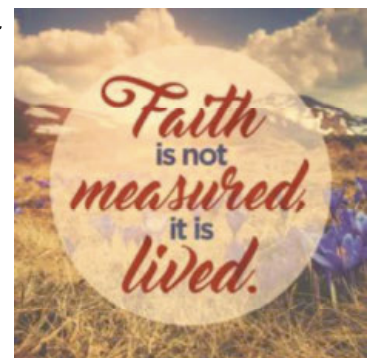

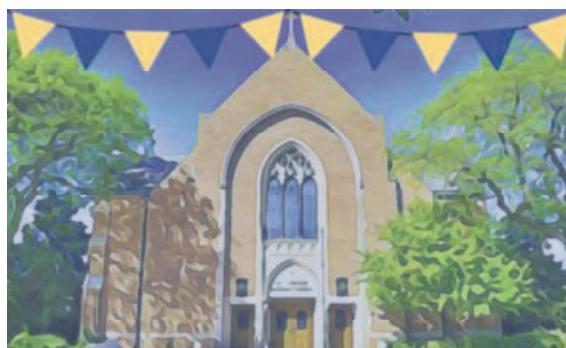

Dear Friends,

MCREST week is August 4th-10th and it is approaching very fast. St. Peter will be hosting women and children at the shelter in Mt. Clemens. We have 4 nights of meals covered, and are still in need of 3 more meals sponsored. We would love to have a family sponsor and or serve a meal. Children are welcome with adult supervision.

Donation suggestions are as follows:

Individual cans of pop, juice and bottled water (non-refrigerated). Large bottles of juice, ice tea or lemonade to serve at dinner.

Pop tarts, muffins, breakfast bars, donuts, individual boxes of cereal.

Fruit, bread, peanut butter, jelly and lunch meat.

Individual packs of condiments such as mayo mustard and ketchup, and individually wrapped hard boiled eggs.

Chips, pretzels, or other single serve salty snacks.

Single servings of sweet snacks-cookies, pudding and fruit cups.

We are also looking for large paper lunch bags, Ziplock bags, plastic silverware, napkins, plates and solo cups.

Other needs include: diapers, any size pull ups, feminine care products, toiletries, regular size laundry pods and fabric softener.

Monetary donations are greatly appreciated. We provide bus passes which are approximately \$1,100.00 We also provide gas cards which run about \$300.00 This all comes from parishioner donations.

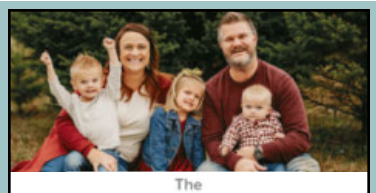
