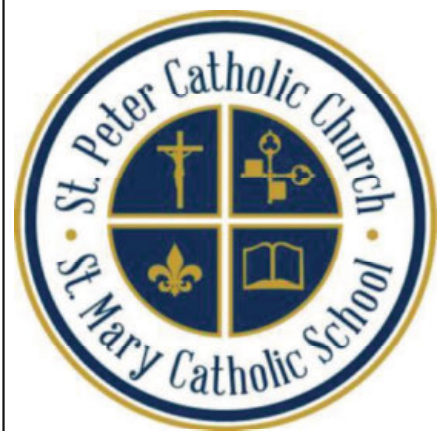

Last week all of the priests of Detroit got together at the seminary with Archbishop Vigneron and watched a wonderful presentation from two exorcists – one from Chicago and one from Oakland, CA. The purpose of the professional development presentation was to remind all of us that evil is real, demons do exist and the evil one himself, Satan, truly does exist. 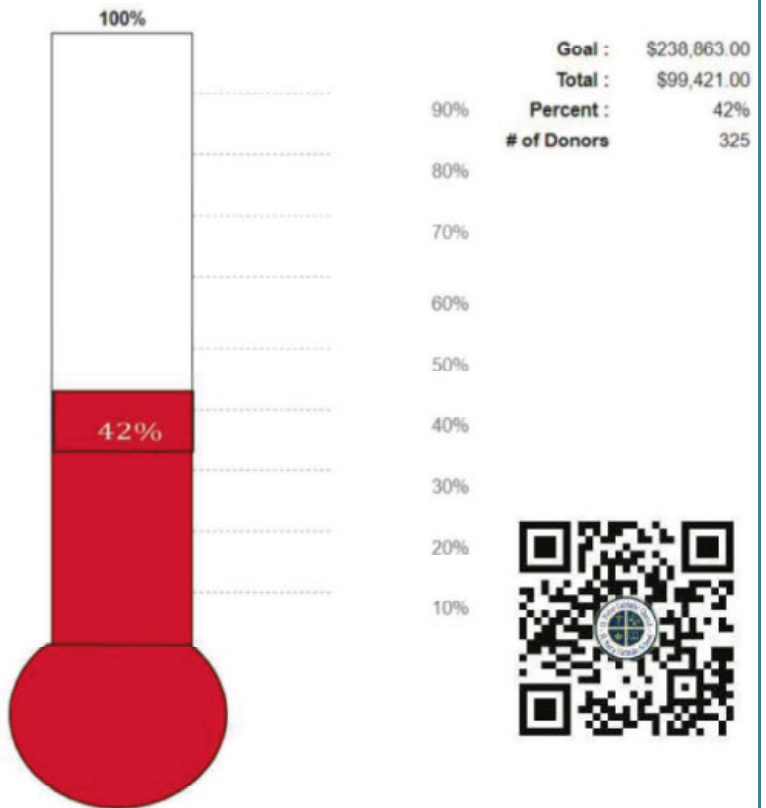
The menu includes French toast, cinnamon French toast, traditional and blueberry pancakes, scrambled eggs, link sausage, juice, milk and, of course, coffee.
