

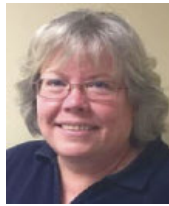

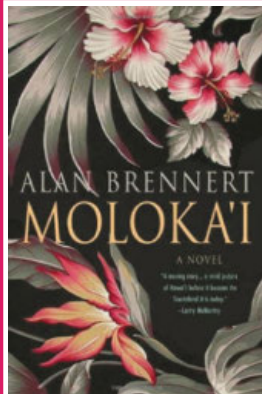

Feast of St. Blaise ~ February 3

Throat Blessings will take place next weekend, February 4/5, at all the Masses.

Before becoming a 4th century bishop of Sebaste in Armenia, St. Blaise was a physician. St. Blaise and other Christian leaders were persecuted by the Roman emperor Licinius and had to flee into the wilderness. According to legend, those who hunted St. Blaise down found him in a cave surrounded by animals, many of which were sick. St. Blaise cured the beasts of their illnesses. St. Blaise saved the life of a boy who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. That is how the tradition of St. Blaise throat blessings began. St. Blaise was commanded by government officials to worship pagan idols. Because he refused, he was tortured and beheaded. St. Blaise is the Patron Saint of Animals and those with Throat Ailments.

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness. Amen.
