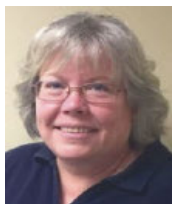
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

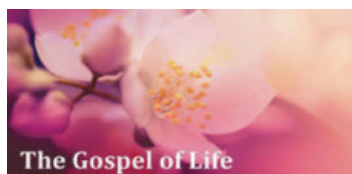
WHITE SHOELACES NEEDED
