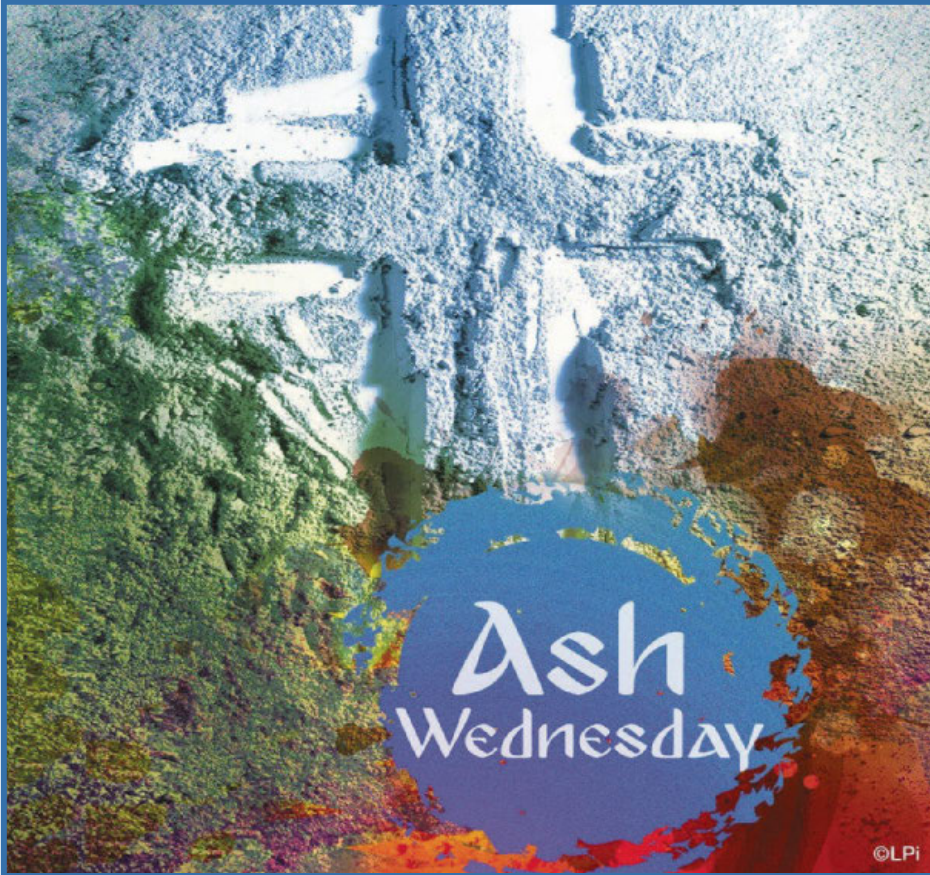

for Our Catholics to Be!**

This weekend, those in the OCIA (those becoming Catholic) celebrate a special ceremony called the Rite of Sending. It will be on Saturday, February 18, at the 5:00 PM Mass. As our catechumens (those to be baptized) and candidates (those to be confirmed, already baptized) begin their final period of preparation leading to the Easter Vigil, they come before the community asking to be recognized for the progress they have made and for our assurances of our continued blessings. After this presentation at St. Edith, they will participate in a ceremony with those around the Archdiocese called the Rite of Election and the Call to Continuing Conversion with the Auxiliary Bishop at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral. This will take place next Saturday, February 25. We ask that the Parish keep them in your prayers.

Almsgiving Report ~ 4th Quarter 2023

We have been blessed to be able to distribute \$4,920 to those in need because of the continued generosity of our St. Edith Parish Family. Due to your kindness and compassion, we have been able to assist organizations that are helping the less fortunate. We donated to the following groups for the 4th Quarter of 2023:

Better Way Detroit (\$984) ~ Better WAY Detroit™ was founded by Fr. Marko Djonovic, a Catholic priest; and today is organized as a 501(3)(c) secular corporation, on which Fr. Marko serves as a member of the governing board. The initiative is currently 100% funded by individual donations which are essential to the continued growth of the program. They provide dignity to those experiencing homelessness by offering the opportunity to work for pay. Better WAY Detroit™ [BWD] engages, pays, feeds, and counsels homeless persons, and connects them to services for housing, medical and mental health care, and stable employment opportunities. In return, BWD participants help community organizations like St. Vincent DePaul-Detroit and Detroit Goodfellows serve the underserved. During the

summer months, they also help clean Detroit parks and neighborhoods of trash and overgrowth to help make them safer.

Gianna House (\$984) ~ The Mission of Gianna House is to provide a safe residence for at-risk, pregnant young mothers-to-be and mothers with their newborn infants who are homeless and/or housing insecure. They provide spiritual, educational, financial literacy, and parenting support skills and resources to young moms as well as to other underserved women in the community. St. Edith has assisted Gianna House in the past, and we recently learned that a pipe burst in December 2022 at their facility causing major damage. We wanted to once again reach out and help this deserving organization.

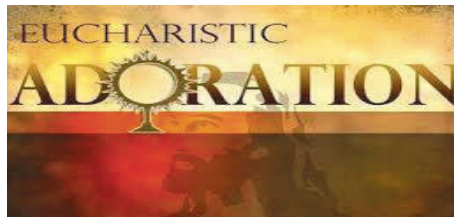
