



LENTEN ALMSGIVING PROJECT ~ Next Weekend

March 4-5 ~ Blessings In A Backpack/Livonia

Next weekend, March 4-5, as part of our Lenten Almsgiving Project, we will be collecting items and/or monetary donations for **Blessings In A Back-pack/Livonia.** Items needed are full size boxes of cereal, boxed Macaroni & Cheese or monetary donations. There will be boxes in the Gathering Area for food donations, and Parishioner Susan Swantick will also be in the Gathering Area after every Mass to collect any monetary donations.

Blessings in a Backpack/Livonia provides meals to children who may need extra help between lunch on Friday and breakfast on Monday. In the Livonia Public Schools, there are nearly 4,000 students that are at risk for food insecurity. These children do not receive sufficient meals or nutrition on the weekend. The unfortunate result is that many students return to school on Mondays tired and hungry and are unable to concentrate or care about their studies.

While **Blessings in a Backpack** is a national organization, our allvolunteer Livonia affiliate is locally run and funded. They currently provide over 500 children at 15 schools in the Livonia district with weekend food packs during the school year. The food they use to fulfill their mission is purchased from both Meijer and Sysco and delivered to the schools on a weekly basis. It costs BIAB-Livonia approximately \$142 per school year to feed a child each weekend, and the number of children in need that we serve continues to grow. No one needing support is ever turned away.

We cannot fulfill our mission without the assistance of community members like you. We gratefully accept monetary donations. Full size boxes of cereal or macaroni and cheese are also most helpful. *Checks should be made payable to: Blessings in a Backpack. In the memo, please note "Livonia Michigan."*


