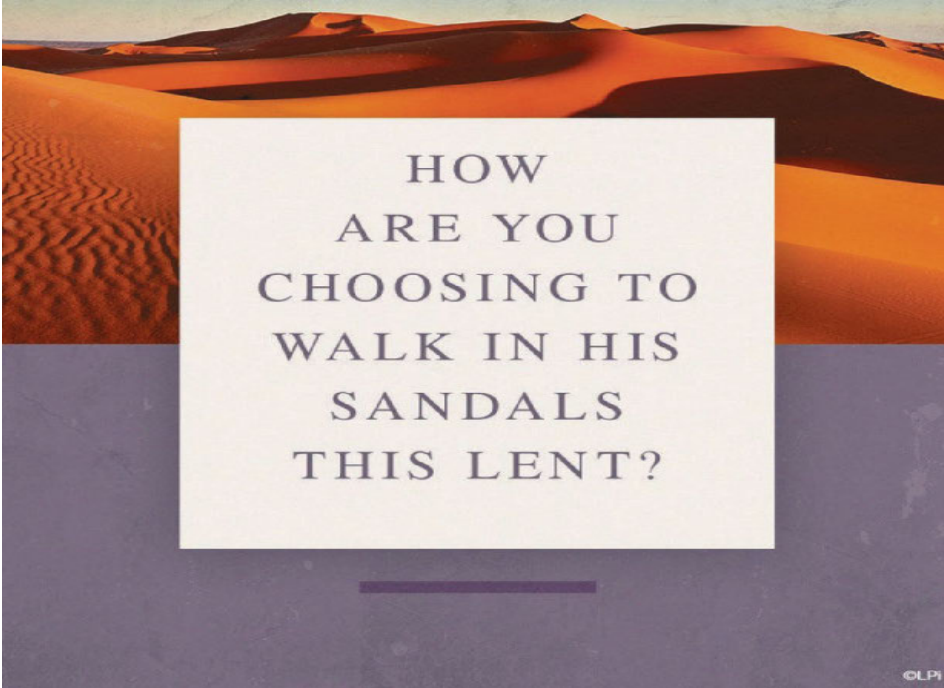

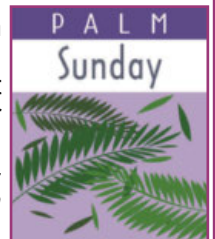
Confirmation Retreats
