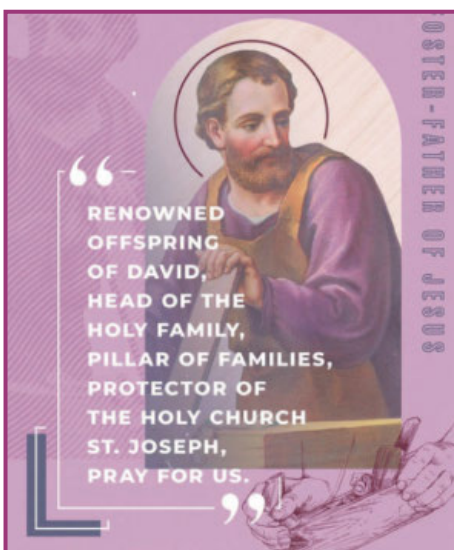
We will welcome you regardless of your present status in the Catholic Church.

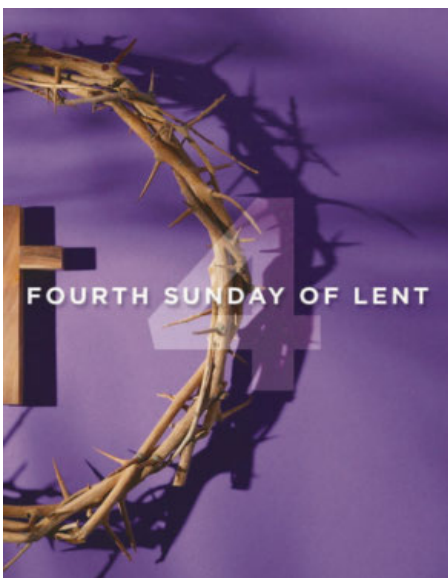

The Gospel of Life

**Every Life is Worth Living
From Conception to Natural Death**

*Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me ...?
(John 14:9)*

“God can be hard to see. It can seem that God hides. I have sometimes found myself pleading for God to come out of hiding and become obvious. But the God I read about in the Scriptures isn't the sort to hide, so where is God? Where are the miracles? The only answer I can come to is that the miracles are all around us; and we can't see them because they're just so ordinary. To remind myself how miraculous ordinary existence is, I look at the trees taking in carbon dioxide, sunlight, water, and a few nutrients to grow. It's the carbon from the air that forms the structure of wood. So the trees are using sunlight and water to make wood out of air. God surely can't be far away!”

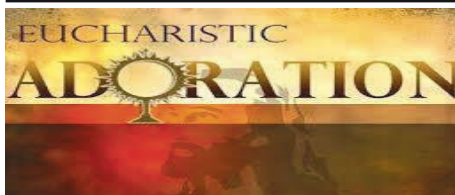
