Holy Week



Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. The purpose of Holy Week is to remember Christ's Passion, which began with his entrance into Jerusalem. Outside the Church, the world goes on as it normally does. If we are going to make this a Holy Week in our lives, we need to make a conscious decision to do so.

On Holy Thursday, we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 PM. At this Mass, we remember the Last Supper, when Jesus instituted the Eucharist. During the Last Supper, he also washed the disciples' feet. When he finished, he said: "As I have done for you, you should also do."

Foot washing is done at this Mass to remind us of our mission to love and serve God by loving and serving one another. We will have a period of Adoration in the Chapel that will begin after the Mass of the Lord's Supper and last until midnight. The Art and Environment volunteers create a beautiful, prayerful environment for the Altar of Repose in the Chapel. I would encourage all of you to come for Adoration on Holy Thursday evening. To ensure that there are people in the Chapel all evening, we are encouraging the following groups to come for a half hour of Adoration according to the schedule below:

On Good Friday, we will have Stations of the Cross at noon and the Liturgy of the Word with distribution of the Eucharist beginning at 1:00 PM. On Holy Saturday, Deacon Don will have a food blessing in Church at 11:00 AM. The Easter Vigil begins at 8:00 PM. We will have the Blessing of the Fire and Preparation of the Candle for Procession inside the Church. We have two adults being Baptized and two who will receive First Eucharist and the Sacrament of Confirmation. Masses on Easter are at 8:30 AM, 11:00 AM and 12:30 PM.

Please try and make this a Holy Week in your life. Turn to the calendar of events for Holy Week and write the things you would like to attend in your calendar. They are once a year events, so take advantage of them if you can. If you are unable to attend, please take time for some extra quiet prayer so that you will be prepared to celebrate the Resurrection. As always, I will be holding all of you in prayer.
