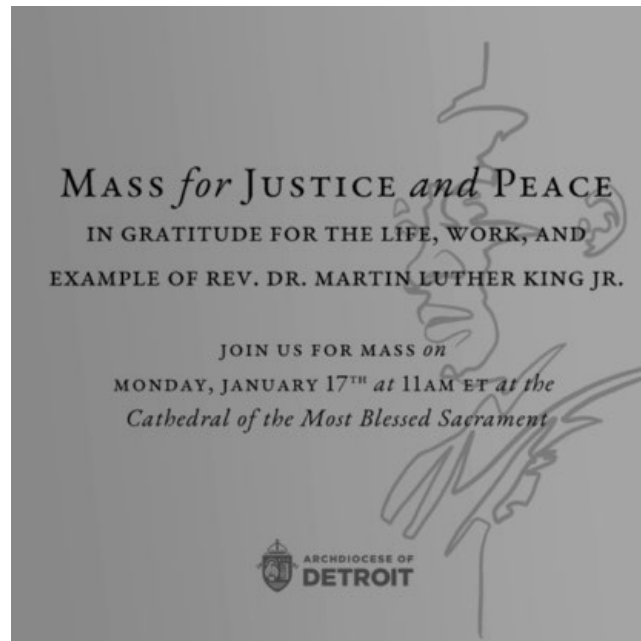
Our local council Duns Scotus #14928 will be holding a membership and food drive at all Masses the of January 15th, 16th, 22nd, and 23rd.

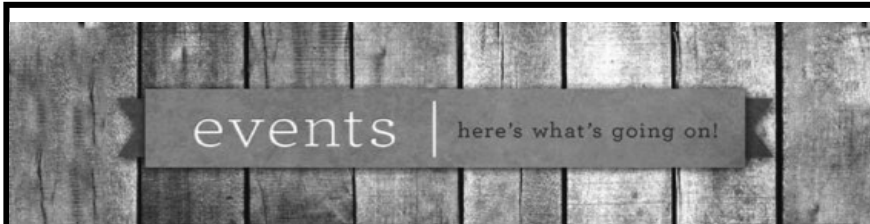


The Franciscan Friars of Transfiguration Parish
