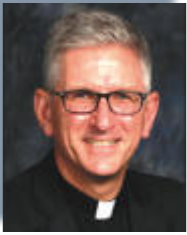

Our Lord does not so much look at the greatness of our actions, or even at their difficulty, as at the love with which we do them" (Saint Thérèse).

Some 9 years ago I unexpectedly was sent from a parish and people whom I dearly loved to Little Flower. Anxiously calling my spiritual director after learning about my reassignment, I vividly recall her immediate response: "David, you know Thérèse is calling you!"

During my first Saturday 4:30pm Mass, there was a sudden commotion after I began the Eucharistic Prayer. Looking up I noticed a medical emergency in the second to last row. Walking around the altar down the middle aisle, I explained we immediately needed to pray for the person in distress and proceeded to the back, was handed the Oil of the Sick – thanks to the omnipresent Jim Sigrist – and anointed the distressed person with everyone in church praying together. After administering the Sacrament, then we prayed aloud for the EMTs as they entered the church responding to the emergency before returning to the altar and continuing with Mass.

It was at that very moment that I knew I had been sent to join you by Christ Jesus, the High Priest. Time and again unforeseen tests and God always providing through you in the beautiful spirit of Saint Thérèse. *Always.*

Deeply personal challenges including the death of my father and *your* faith, hope and love helped carried me through the pain of the loss which never actually ends.

We boldly set out to live as *intentional disciples*. This stirred us to take action in many impressive ways: remodeling our church, expanding Saint Vincent de Paul outreach, growing Saint Benedict School, starting ACTS Retreats, launching LifeTeen and Purpose to vitalize our young church, creating new outdoor spaces with the Courtyard and Pavilion, refashioning the Prayer Garden original church site and partnering with Sunshine Communities to help establish two new homes each with 8 medically fragile residents who we know as friends, and many, many, many more meaningful milestones proclaiming our love of God and love of neighbor.

Most significantly, we moved nearly twice as many people to encounter the Living God alongside us at weekend Masses. Our lively faith also inspired an utterly amazing increase in Baptisms and Weddings along with hundreds of people choosing to join us as members.

As I prepare to begin a new chapter in my priestly life at Christ the King Parish, I do so a better man, Christian and priest than when I first arrived with you. Words simply are insufficient in trying to express the depth of my gratitude to all of you, each in your own personal way permitting God to shine through you to radiate a spectacular light scattering the darkness and providing a place for everyone within the community of intentional disciples we know as Little Flower Parish and Saint Benedict School.

My final day with you will be Sunday, January 2, 2022. I am depending on your continuing prayers for God to use me as His priestly instrument of mercy and peace as He sets forth for me to do.

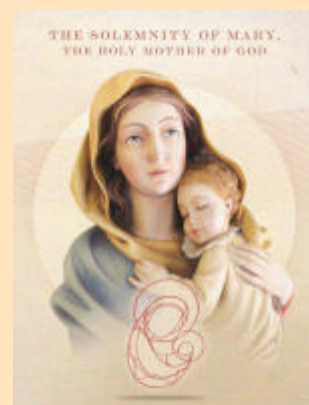
The Story of the Nativity: The Truth of Christmas.
