When Bona was about 10 years old, she had a vision of Jesus, Mary, St. James and some other Saints. It frightened her and so she ran from the vision. St. James went to her and led her back to the image of Jesus. St. Bona observed a devotion to St. James after that and from a very young age fasted on bread and water 3 days a week. Four years later she traveled to see her father in the Holy Land during the Crusades. On the way home she was captured and imprisoned. She was rescued by her countrymen and completed her trip home. Soon after, Bona was named the official guide of The Knights of St. James and took pilgrims on the long and dangerous thousand-mile journey to Santiago de Compostela where St. James is honored. Bona traveled along this pilgrim route and completed the trip 9 times. May St. Bona of Pisa be your travel companion and always lead you to Jesus!
