**Realign Resources for Mission (RRM) update:**

Father Vincent and the parish office staff recently attended meetings with the Diocese to be updated on the draft proposal from the RRM Committee. Currently, the proposal is for Immaculate Conception Church, St. Andrew's (Saline), St. Mary's (Manchester) and St. Joseph's (Whittaker) to be grouped together. The priests from those four parishes will work together to provide services to parishioners. The priests will be led by one priest designated the "moderator" who will make assignments within the group. For the time being, each parish will continue to operate its own programs, ministries and services and will maintain its own resources and budgets. The RRM Committee received feedback from the priests and office staff at their meetings and are using this information to refine their proposal. They will be scheduling meetings with parishioners throughout the Diocese to present the draft proposal and seek feedback before making a final proposal to Bishop Boyea on October 1, 2021.
