Youth Group is open to all high school students. We plan to meet twice a month during the school year.

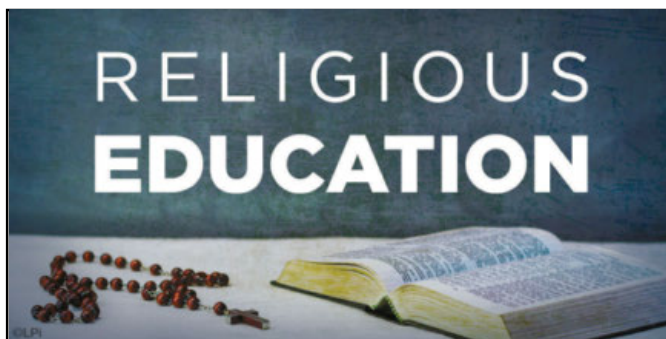
