



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Feast of the Epiphany or the Baptism of Jesus Christ. This feast is known as "AL-DENNAH," meaning "manifestation" or "shining' because the light of Christ shines among us as God's Son is the Light of the World. We can also call this feast "the second Christmas", or the second birth of our Lord. In the eastern churches the celebration of the Epiphany focuses on both: the birth of our Lord and His baptism.

In this feast, Jesus begins His public life with His baptism by John in the river Jordan, where the Father and the Holy Spirit are witnesses. He is the beloved Son of the Father and the Spirit of God rests upon Him. It is the feast of the manifestation of the Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The Feast of Epiphany reminds us not only of the baptism of Christ, but also of our own baptism. It is for this reason that we bless Holy Water on this day. At His baptism in the river Jordan, Jesus teaches us about baptism as the source of life. He Himself did not need it, but in His mercy He wanted to show us the right way. He set an example for us all and told us that my heavenly Father is your Father too.

God speaks again not only from heaven, but through Jesus Christ, His priests, and people, the church. Today we hear a special call from God, so listen and open your heart to Him! Allow Him to renew your Baptism promises and become again a shining light in the church and in the world.
