

In preparation for the Synod of Bishops that will take place in the Vatican in October 2023, Pope Francis has invited all Catholics around the world to offer their opinions regarding how the Church should journey together in its mission of evangelization in the future.

### **PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, A word from Pope Francis ~

"There is never a reason to lose hope. Jesus says:
"I am with you until the end of the world."

I am sure that all of us could tell from the moment we walked into the Church today (or watching via Live stream) and noticed the white altar cloths, that we are now in a new season of our Church Liturgical Year. As is the case in our homes, gone are the decorations of Christmas. As best as we are able during these COVID-19 times, we have returned to the everyday routines of our lives. This season of the Church year is simply called "Epiphany" - the Baptism of Jesus. We will be in the first part of this "white season" of the year until Ash Monday on February 28th.
