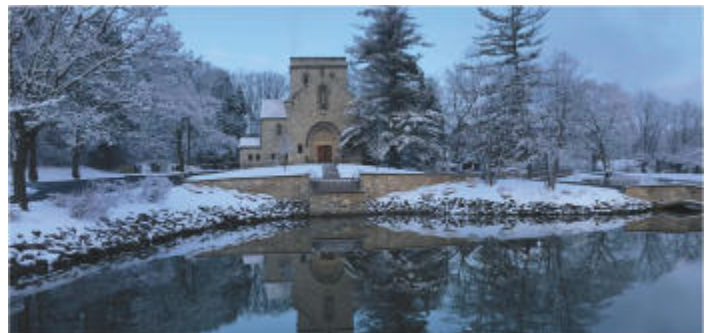

### FROM THE DESK OF FR. MARK BRAUER

***Welcoming Our Guests at Christmas*** - When we come to celebrate the Christmas liturgy, there will be many guests to our parish. This will be an opportunity for all of us to be Christ to them. The question is “How?”

Consider how you prepare for guests to arrive at your home. How do you prepare for their arrival? We usually greet our guests when they enter our home. But, what about the guests who come to our church doors throughout the year as well as once or twice a year. Do we welcome them in the same way?

As we continue to prepare for the Second Coming of Christ and Christmas let us prepare our hearts to welcome our guests at the Christmas liturgies. Pray to the Lord that he will use you as an instrument of His love and peace. Pray that our guests will experience Christ’s presence in the Eucharist and in the assembly.

Also, instead of being upset that your parking place is taken, or your seat is occupied by a “stranger”, say “Hello” and introduce yourself and welcome that person to our parish. Say “Merry Christmas” to them and offer them a sincere welcome. One of the principles of evangelization is that we are leading people primarily to a Person, not simply a human institution. We are each called to encounter Christ directly and let ourselves become, as St. Paul often said, “Like Christ.” In practical terms, this means that our focus should not be on someone’s involvement in the parish, but instead on their relationship with Christ. Our goal for such persons is that they encounter Jesus Christ in the sacraments and through prayer.

Christmas was first celebrated in Rome on December 25th, in the year 336 AD. Although, we do not know the exact date of the birth of Jesus, December 25th was chosen for the following three reasons.

First, in the Northern Hemisphere at the winter solstice around December 22, the days slowly begin to lengthen. Our experience of the growing light from the sun is an echo of the Gospel of John: *"Jesus must grow greater; I, John the Baptist must grow smaller"* (John 3:30).

Second, the church hoped to overcome the pagan festivals of *"sun worship"* and the birthday of the Unconquered Sun, which were celebrated around December 25<sup>th</sup>, and replace them with a celebration of the birth of the real light of the world, Jesus the Son of God.

Third, the church dated Christmas on December 25th because it was nine months from the traditional date of his conception on March 25<sup>th</sup> or the feast of the Annunciation of Mary. The feast of Christmas celebrates both conception and birth.

Whatever the exact historical inspiration, December 25th is the day the Church celebrates the mystery of the Incarnation: *"by the power of the Holy Spirit Jesus was born of the Virgin Mary and became human."* The solemn feast of Christmas spread rapidly throughout the Western world, and in the East the feast was

celebrated on Epiphany. The reason probably was the results of the Nicaea Council in 325, which affirmed that Jesus was both divine and human, he is one substance with God the Father, and there is an equality between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in the Trinity. The Arian heresy on the other hand said Jesus was distinct or subordinate to God the Father. The Nicaea Council condemned the Arian heresy.

On Christmas, the darkness is driven away with the light of Christ. It is this day that we gather around the Christmas tree lights and remember that Jesus is the light of the world. It is this day that we open our homes to every guest and remember that the light of Christ has entered our world to dwell with us in the most humble and vulnerable of human circumstance. As the opening prayer echoes in the *"Mass at Dawn"*: *"Grant, we pray, almighty God, that, as we are bathed in the new radiance of your incarnate Word, the light of faith, which illumines our minds, may also shine through in our deeds. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen."* (2011 *The Roman Missal*, p37)

In the 2011 Roman Missal (RM) acknowledges this feast is so important that there are four different Mass texts and Scripture readings for Christmas.

### 1. **At the Vigil Mass:**

The opening prayer recalls welcoming the first coming of Jesus and reminds us of the second coming *"when he comes again as our Judge"* (RM p35).

The Gospel reading from Matthew recalls the genealogy of Jesus Christ from Abraham to David and the willingness of Joseph to take Mary into his home (Lectionary #13).

### 2. **At the Mass during the Night:**

The opening prayer recalls: *"this most sacred night radiant with the splendor of the true light"* (RM p36).

The Gospel reading from Luke recalls the requirement for Joseph and Mary to be enrolled in their own town. While they were in the city of David or Bethlehem, it was time for Mary to give birth. An angel appeared to the shepherds telling them the savior has been born (Lectionary #14).

### 3. **At the Mass at Dawn:**

The opening prayer recalls the light shining upon us: *"the light of faith, which illumines our minds, may also shine through in our deeds"* (RM p37).

The gospel reading from Luke recalls the shepherds going to Bethlehem in haste, finding Mary, Joseph and Jesus lying in a manger, and giving glory and praise to God. Mary ponders all these experiences in her heart (Lectionary #15).

### 4. **At the Mass during the Day:**

The opening prayer recalls our desire to become like Christ: *"May we share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity"* (RM p38). The Gospel reading from John recalls John the Baptist *"was sent from God ... to testify to the light, so that all might believe"* (Lectionary #16).

## COVID-19 LITURGICAL PROTOCOLS

by The Archdiocese of Detroit



With the rise in COVID-19 infections and, particularly, hospitalizations in our community, we wish to remind all parishes of our current COVID-19 protocols.

*December 13, 2021*

With the recent increase in COVID-19 cases in Michigan, and the approaching winter season, we wish to remind clergy and parishes of the Archdiocese of Detroit's current guidelines for liturgies:

- The Archdiocese of Detroit encourages Mass-goers, regardless of vaccination status, to wear face-coverings and to practice social distancing to reduce exposure to COVID-19.
- The Archdiocese of Detroit strongly recommends that each pastor/In Solidum team should evaluate their location in the Archdiocese and implement the following protocols:
  - Establish an area where social distancing is observed
  - Strongly encourage masking and social distancing for all Mass-goers
- Require all who distribute Holy Communion to wear face-coverings and use hand sanitizer
- Hang signage indicating masking and social distancing are strongly encouraged
- Ensure that hand sanitizer is readily available at church entrances and near the sanctuary
- Evaluate space for the choir, and strongly recommend that those who are unvaccinated do not participate in the choir at this time
- The faithful are reminded that dispensations from the obligation to participate in Holy Mass remain in effect for people who are ill or who find themselves in other specific circumstances.

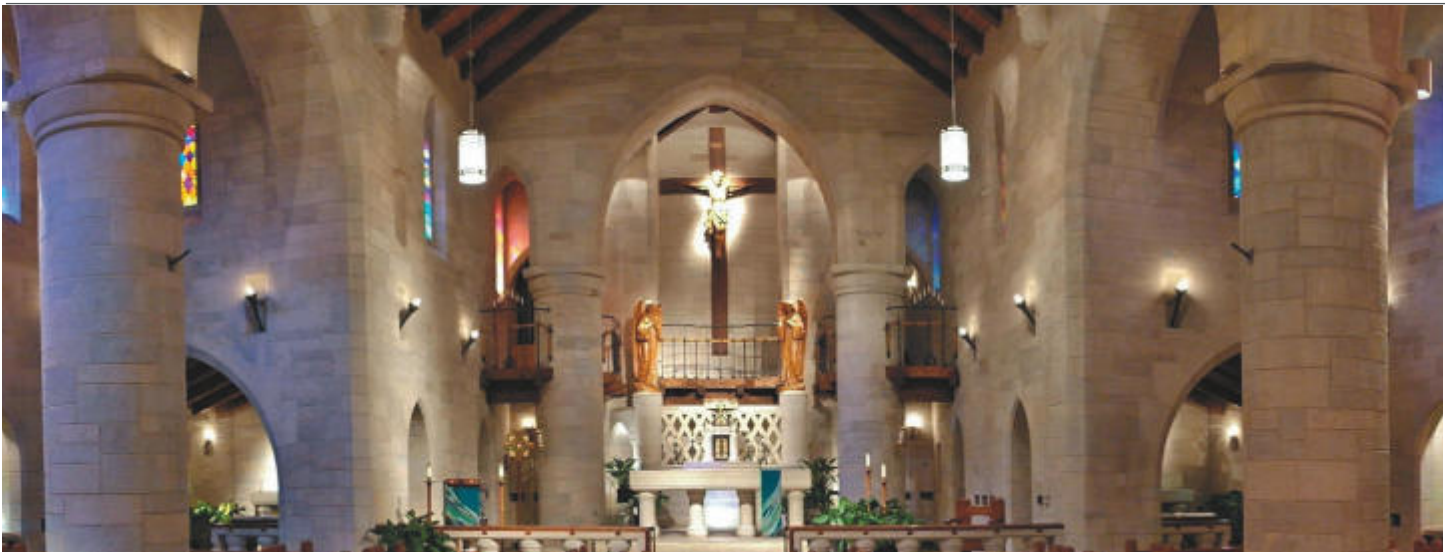
