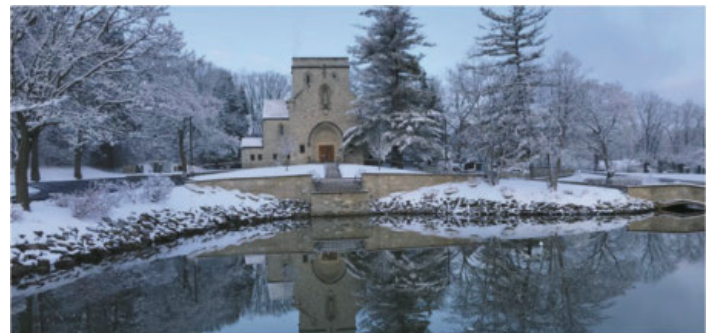

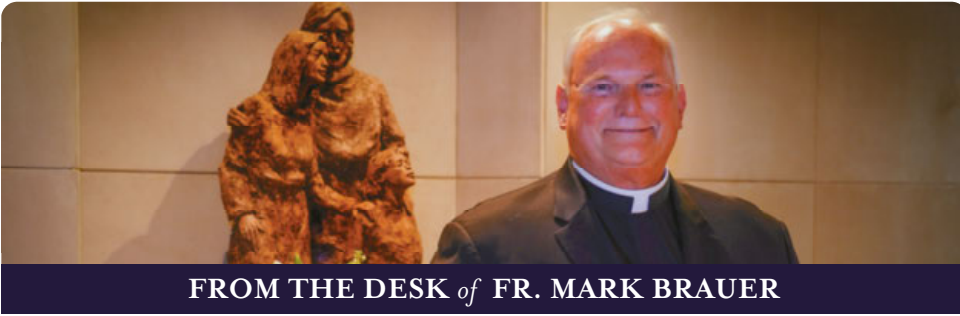

FROM THE DESK of FR. MARK BRAUER

Next Sunday, January 30th, Catholic Schools throughout the country will begin the celebration of Catholic Schools Week. The theme for National Catholic Schools Week 2022 is **“Catholic Schools: Faith, Excellence, Service”**. Parents choose Catholic Schools for a variety of reasons, here are a few: Catholic Schools offer an education that combines Catholic faith and teachings with academic excellence; Catholic Schools partner with parents in the faith formation of their children; Catholic Schools provide a balance academic curriculum that integrates faith, culture and life; Catholic Schools use technology effectively to enhance education; Catholic Schools instill in students the value of service to others; Catholic Schools emphasize moral development and self-discipline; Catholic Schools prepare students to be productive citizens and future leaders; Catholic Schools cultivate a faculty and staff of people who are dedicated, caring and effective and lastly Catholic Schools provide a safe and welcoming environment for all.

It is a known fact that Catholic Schools communities best contributes to the political, social, and economic life of the nation by adhering to these standards of academic excellence and moral conduct so that our graduates according to their abilities will know how to think and how to express their thoughts in words

and action with clarity, conviction and above all, with integrity.

St. Hugo Catholic School fosters development in the following areas: *Spiritual* – to strengthen and deepen a faith in action; *Academic* – to motivate and challenge the child to appreciate his/her full intellectual and physical abilities; and *Social* – to promote growth in the understanding of self and others.

### WORDS TO PONDER...

What do we mean when we say that we make a sacrifice? We say, for example, I have sacrificed my career for my children! I sacrificed a lot for my job! Love demands that we make sacrifices! Sometimes we must sacrifice life itself for the sake of integrity! Christ sacrificed himself for our sins! The Eucharist is a sacrifice!

From what is common in all these expressions, we can extract the dictionary definition of sacrifice: **“the surrender of something of value for the sake of something else.”** This is a good definition, but in terms of its understanding as prayer and as Eucharist, more must be added.

St. Augustine defined sacrifice by saying that it is an act, through which we enter into deeper communion with God and each other, and that the sacrifice opens us to deeper communion by changing and stretching the heart of the one offering it.

When we add St. Augustine’s definition to that of the dictionary, we see that sacrifice works this way: **“To make a sacrifice is to surrender something out of love, something that is ours and is painful to give away, and to let the pain of that surrender stretch and change our hearts in such a way that we are now more open to communion with God and others.”**

May we keep our eyes on Jesus and be grateful to God for sacrificing his only beloved Son for our salvation!

The celebration of St. Antony took place on Monday, January 17. St. Antony was born in Egypt in 250 AD. At eighteen years of age, after his parents died, Antony distributed his property to the poor, and placed his younger sister in a convent. He began a life of penance, withdrew into solitude, and sought out an ascetic man to be his teacher of prayer. At thirty-five years of age, Antony decided to go out into the desert to continue his solitude in prayer and penance. He became known as the Father of Monasticism, and the Father of All Monks. At 105 years of age, Antony died in 356 AD.

Saint Athanasius wrote “The Life of Saint Antony”, which was a best seller in ancient times. Antony is important because he attracted

disciples, worked on behalf of the Church, gave support to believers during the Diocletian persecution, and assisted Saint Athanasius, Bishop and Doctor of the Church.

The disciples of Antony tried to imitate his way of life, and they established settlements or communities in the Egyptian desert. One settlement was located at *Nitria* and 6,000 monks lived in community. Another settlement was located at *Cellia* and 600 monks lived in community. These settlements were designed with individual dwellings for hermits, bakeries, a Church, and a guest house, so people from the cities could come for a week of prayer and penance (like our experience of a retreat). The monks would seek employment to support themselves. Today, people are still living in community in some of these ancient settlements.

The celebration of this feast provides an opportunity for us to consider going on a retreat. A retreat is a time set apart from usual pursuits to give attention to one’s spiritual wellbeing. A retreat is an opportunity to deepen our faith. A retreat may focus on specific needs such as preparation for marriage or discernment in making an important decision. A retreat is usually conducted at centers established expressly for that purpose. A retreat may be made with a group or by yourself with an aid of a spiritual director. During COVID, you can find virtual or online retreats offered by many Catholic organizations.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.”** (2011 *The Roman Missal*, p657)

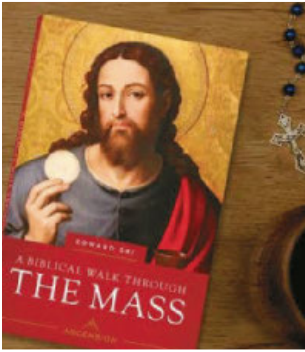

## ADULT CATHOLICS: DO YOU NEED TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION?

Three times a year (fall, winter, spring), Confirmation preparation sessions are offered to prepare adults for the Celebration of Confirmation. Adult Confirmation preparation sessions are held in-person on Sunday mornings in the parish office conference room, from 9-10 AM.

Confirmation may be received at different times throughout the year: first, at the parish celebration at St. Hugo of the Hills Church on **Saturday, January 29, 2022, at 11 AM Mass** or second, at the Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament on **Pentecost Sunday, June 5, 2022, at 11 AM Mass**. The Archdiocese of Detroit does recommend for adults to participate in their parish celebration. When this is not possible, adults are invited to participate in the Cathedral's Confirmation ceremonies.

### **What do you need to do?**

It is a simple three step process.

**First Step:** You need to have been baptized and received Communion in the Catholic Church. If not, you need to register for the RCIA process.

**Second Step:** Candidates for Confirmation are asked to complete the preparation sessions before the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Session 3 = Sunday, May 22, 9-10 AM

Please bring to the first session a recent copy of your Baptismal Certificate with notations. We ask that you contact the church of your Baptism and request a "new"

Baptismal Certificate with notations (issued within the last 6 months). You will need to choose a Confirmation Sponsor: a sponsor must be over 16 years of age; be a practicing Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist; and not be the father or mother of the one to be confirmed (cf. CCC 874). Canon Law states: *"It is desirable that the one who undertook the role of sponsor at baptism be sponsor for confirmation"* (CCC 893).

**Third Step:** You need to attend the Adult Confirmation preparation sessions, which are held in-person on Sunday mornings in the office conference room, from 9-10 AM.

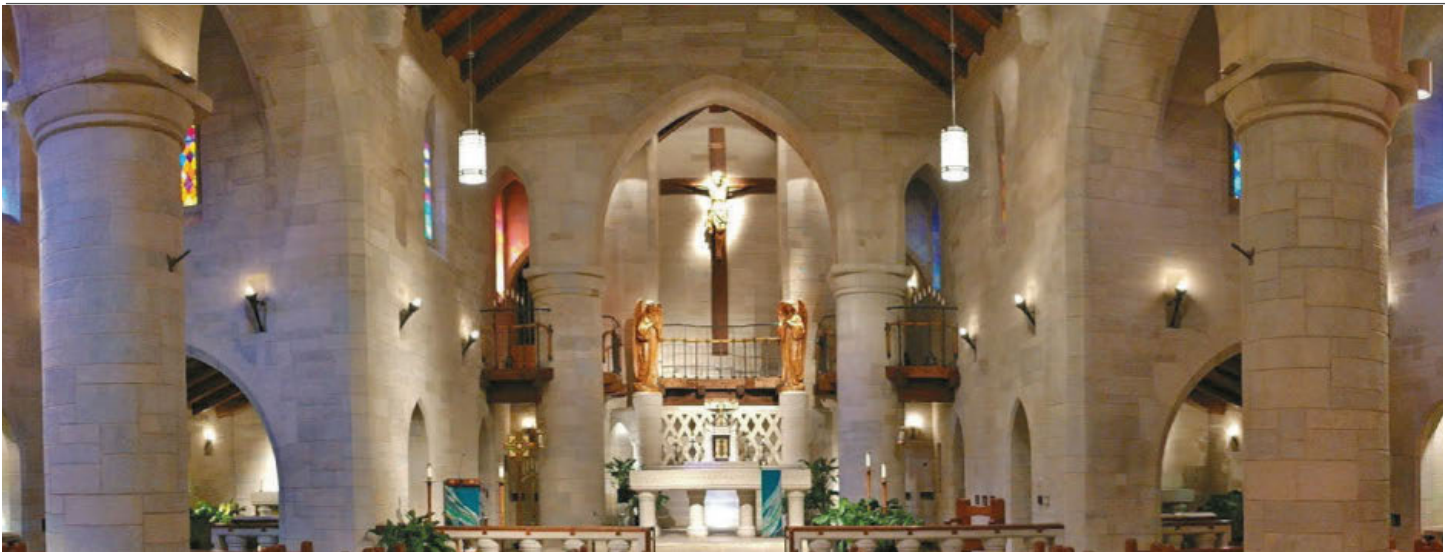
