

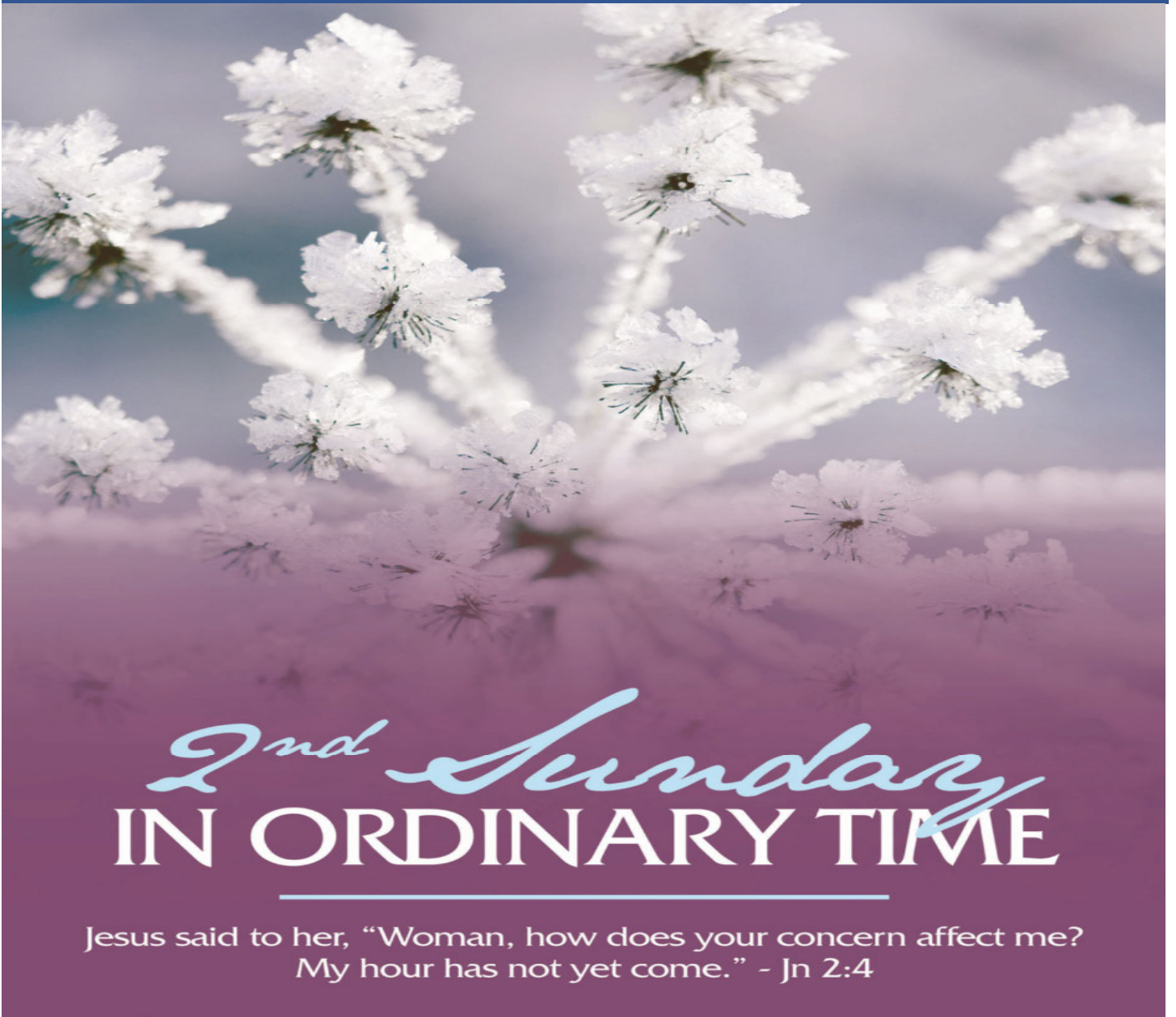

Christmas. Thanks to everyone who assisted with taking down the Christmas decorations. The new décor seemed to please everyone, and it was a new fresh look that complimented the renovation. One aspect that people liked was the placing of the outdoor creche scene above the breezeway(that’s the name given to the space between the outer and inner doors). In the initial staging of the figurines, one of the kings was missing but there was the figurine of a woman. I received and inquiry as to the identity of the woman. I have never known a creche to have a woman, other than Mary, in the manger scene. Luke provides an answer to the question. In the second chapter, Luke described the familiar of an inn with no vacancy. In that time inns were a place for travelers to lodge. Attached to the lodge was a courtyard that had stalls for animals. The female figurine holds a small basket with what appears to be small cakes and the other hand carries a jug. Once can deduce from this figure that she was the innkeeper.

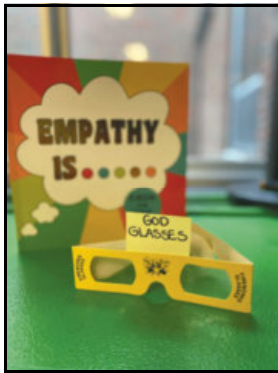
In 1st grade, besides learning how to read and write, my students are also learning about the importance of empathy. Empathy is being able to know how someone else is feeling, even when you aren't in the same situation. Sometimes, in more simple words, we call empathy being able to "put yourself in someone's shoes" and see things from their view. Why is empathy important? Empathy is the first step in having positive relationships because it helps us understand and relate to others. Although

we were all born with the innate capacity to see things from another person's perspective, empathy is still something that needs to be taught, developed, nurtured and practiced.

Every morning, my 1st graders gather together for a Morning Meeting. Throughout the month of January, we are focusing on empathy through stories, videos, role play, and discussions. One of the students favorite activities is using "God Glasses" to see God in everyone and everything around them. When we realize that God is in each and every one of us, it helps us see past our differences and find what unites us. By being aware of other's feelings and imagining what it might be like to be in their position, my students are learning kindness, respect, compassion, and acceptance of others.
