Parish Notes

Catholic Services Appeal. The first weekend in May inaugurated the annual Catholic Services Appeal (CSA). The parish goal for this year is \$151,921, a 3.43% increase over last year. The CSA is the funding source for the various ministries supported by the Archdiocese of Detroit. Some of the ministries offered by the Archdiocese assist individuals in need of healing, like the ministry of Project Rachel that aids women suffering from the emotional effects of abortion. For many this tragic event took place when they were young and felt alone or abandoned. The ministry of Project Rachel offers the compassion of Christ that brings healing to a wounded heart.

Another ministry very necessary in this age of the breakdown of marriages and the family unit is the marriage Tribunal. The mission of the Tribunal is twofold. First it is to determine the sacramental validity of a marriage, and may declare a marriage annulled. The other aspect, as of equal importance, offer healing and hope to a person who has experienced the effects of divorce so to provide closure and healing. These ministries of healing are funded solely by the CSA at no cost to the participants. Your contribution to the CSA provides the necessary resources that permit the Archdiocese to respond to the needs of its people and parishes.

In recent years I have begun this appeal highlighting these two ministries because of the importance of bringing healing to those in need. Please prayerfully consider supporting the ministries of the Archdiocese by contributing to the CSA. To contribute, mailings are sent directly to registered households, or you may donate on-line to GiveCSA.org, or you contact the parish office. I hope that you will support this year's appeal.

Congratulations Confirmandi. On May 7th, Bishop Jeffrey Monforton, confirmed the eight-graders from St. Michael's School and our Religious Education program. I congratulate you for accepting this sacrament, and I pray that you will seek the counsel of the Holy Spirit in all the choices that you will make in your life. May the Spirit lead you to seek what is right and just and keep you strong in faith and discipleship.

First Holy Communion. On May 3rd and May 4th the second graders of St. Michael School and its Religious Education program received their First Holy Communion. I congratulate these young members of our faith community as they have received and experienced Jesus in this most personal way. Our Lord, as I told them, has entered into them in this spiritual and physical way so that they will receive the grace needed to enter into a life of Christ. May you always believe and trust in his presence in the Eucharist and in your life.



2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope." – United States Conference of Catholic Bishops

His First Words: The Urbi et Orbi Blessing

Pope Leo XIV delivered his first address from St. Peter's Basilica, known as the *Urbi et Orbi* ("to the city and to the world") blessing. The first words of this short, prayerful message, which he gave from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica following the "*Habemus Papam*!" announcement, were "Peace be with all of you!" He continued by saying, "The world needs Christ's light. Humanity needs him to be the bridge so that God and his love can reach us."

These remarks set a tone of hope, reconciliation, and a focus on Christ as the source of unity and peace for humanity. Pope Leo XIV's initial address was resonant, highlighting both a blessing for all and the essential role of faith in bridging divisions and bringing God's love to the world.


