The Most Holy Trinity

In creative celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, pray a rosary with creation. Find a quiet place outside or sit near a window. Contemplate the amazing Divine Gift that is before you. Admire it. Study it. Become one with it. Ask for the guidance of Brother St. Francis as you pray: "You, Holy Father, are King of heaven and earth. You are three in one, God above all gods. You are good, all good, and supreme good, Lord God, living and true. You are love. You are beauty. You are gentleness. You are joy. You are hope and happiness." Admire the wonder and majesty of God in all that is around you. Ask for wisdom and understanding.

Begin each decade with the Our Father and conclude with the Glory Be.

Decade one: Contemplate God the Father. As you pray each bead with a Hail Mary, get lost in the grandeur of all that you see. Imagine the thousands and thousands of years of history that is before you. Envision a time when nothing existed. What is nothing? Lift your eyes, heart, and soul to the power and magnificence of the universe, its expanse and its endlessness. You are one with it all. God's creative power.

Decade two: Contemplate God the Son. Behold the squirrels, birds, and critters all conducting life's business. They have heartbeats just like yours. Praying each bead, become one with the incarnate divine life that flows through you and flows with the smallest of creatures. It is holy innocence and blessed life. Tenderness. Compassion, Mercy. Reverence. All want to be held, have a home, and be loved. God in all things. Emmanuel.

Decade three: Contemplate God the Holy Spirit. The changing of times and seasons happens often without notice. It is all within God's care and guided. We all belong. Behold the living, dying, and rising to new life. You are one with all time from beginning into eternity.

Decade Four: Contemplate God as One.

Decade Five: Contemplate God as three. All different while remaining one. The divine dance is being danced

before you. Rest in what you see. Become what you see. We are all connected: God of the Holy Trinity, creation, our brothers and sisters, the animals, and the plants.

The rosary you have prayed celebrates the circle of connectedness and the intimate relationship we share with all things: a glimpse of the Trinity.

June is Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month

Psalm 70: 17-19 "O God, you have taught me from my youth, and till the present I proclaim your wondrous deeds; and now that I am old and gray, O God, forsake me not till I proclaim your strength to every generation that is to come."

Did you know that 6.5 million people in America are living with Alzheimer's disease? (Alzheimer Association) This is about 60-80% of people diagnosed with dementia. What is dementia? Dementia is a general term for loss of memory, language, problem-solving and other thinking abilities that are severe enough to interfere with daily life (Alzheimer Association). There are multiple types of Vascular dementia: Alzheimer disease, dementia (microscopic bleeding and/or blood vessel blockage in the Lewy body, Frontotemporal, Huntington's, Parkinson's disease dementia, Mixed dementia and others.

How is dementia diagnosed? There is no specific test for dementia. A physician or specialist will take a careful history, a complete physical exam, lab and radiological tests and assess for changes in thinking, day-to-day function and behavior. The medical care provider must rule out medical conditions that can mimic dementia. It is not unusual for a family physician or medical provider to send a person to a specialist for a second opinion and definitive diagnosis.

There is no known preventative or treatment for most causes of dementia. We have no treatment for aging or genetics but research has shown that a healthy lifestyle can reduce some risk: healthy diet, not smoking, regular exercise, cognitive stimulation and properly managing some chronic health conditions.


Here are 10 early signs and symptoms of Alzheimer's disease (alz.org). For full information and a detailed

description of each early sign go to their website at www.alz.org.

- 1. Memory loss that disrupts daily life.
- 2. Challenges in planning and solving problem.
- 3. Difficulty completing familiar tasks.
- Confusion with time or place.
- Trouble understanding visual images and spatial relationships.
- 6. New problems with words in speaking or writing.
- 7. Misplacing things and losing the ability to retrace steps.
- 8. Decreased or poor judgement.
- 9. Withdrawal from work or social activities.
- 10. Change in mood and personality.

If you or a loved one notice one or more signs it is natural to feel scared and concerned. It is possible you will become worried or upset another person, but it is important to seek medical care and be evaluated. There are medical conditions that can mimic the symptoms of dementia that are treatable. It is also important to discuss the ramification of a true dementia disease and how to care for yourself and your loved ones. Pray for the caregivers in our church community – they are God's love. - 3. Valley Area Agency on Aging: 810-239-7671, 1-800-978-6275 in state toll free, valleyaaa.org. They offer many services for in home care in conjunction with the Lapeer County Health Department. They also offer in person and virtual support services for the caregiver.
- 4. Michigan Long Term Ombudsman Program: 866-485-9393 toll free. They advocate in behalf of people living in nursing homes and assisted living facilities. They will pursue complaints and help families find appropriate facilities for placing a loved one.
- Michigan Department of Health & Human Services Adult Protective Services: 855-444-3911 toll free. They investigate reports of allegations of abuse, neglect or exploitation of vulnerable adults.

Northern Lapeer County Family of Parishes CSA 2022


