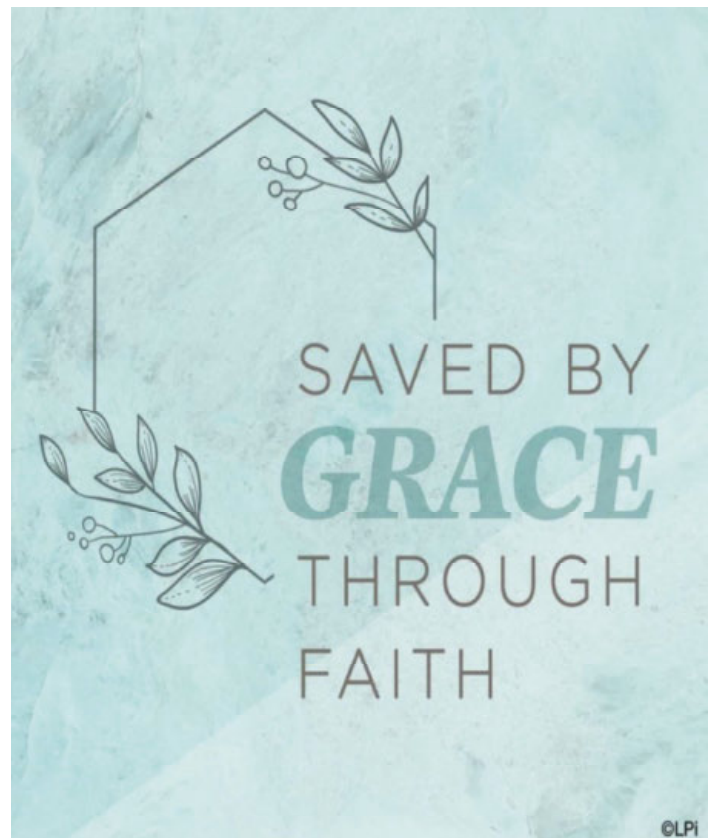
### **15th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

We can learn a great deal from Mister Rogers. Remember him? He was the gentle soul who found his way into living rooms worldwide starting as far back as 1968. Mister Rogers' Neighborhood was a beloved program that celebrated and exalted people, especially children. He taught us that we are neighbors and that everyone has a place. Everyone matters. He had a vision, born of his relationship with God that highlighted every human life's innocence, beauty, and uniqueness. To that end, he called us to be responsible for each other, saying nothing different than what Jesus said. Viewers quickly learned that life is not just about me.

"We live in a world in which we need to share responsibility. It's easy to say, 'It's not my child, not my community, not my world, not my problem.' Then there are those who see the need and respond. I consider those people my heroes (Fred Rogers)." It is so easy to look the other way. After all, I'm not the one who needs to leave home out of fear and try to find somewhere safe. I am not the one who is hungry and without shelter or food. I am not the one who has a child being bullied or ridiculed because of the way they dress or act. I am not the one being threatened with violence or unable to find meaningful work. The distress and agony of our neighbors are our distress and agony. We cannot walk by it with an attitude of indifference, especially if we call ourselves believers. When we no longer care, we have suffocated our souls. This is a great sin.

God's law "is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry

it out." We all have a need for love and acceptance. That's why Mister Rogers' television show was so popular. It spoke to something deeper, something sacred about humanity. God didn't give us his law in a book. He wrote it on our hearts. We know what we need to do. It's a matter of choice. Love is sacred. When we love another human being, especially without regard for ourselves, it is a holy moment. These moments are often missed due to our self-serving agendas and rules.

The Gift Shop is located in SS. Peter & Paul's Gathering Space and is open after Masses on the weekends or call the cluster office to make arrangements during office hours.

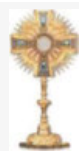

- Baby and child proof the entire house.
- Use child-resistant containers whenever possible. But remember they are child-resistant, not child proof, and they are not a guarantee that your child won't be able to open the product.
- Do not store food products and household cleaners in the same cabinet — it can be confusing to a hungry child looking for food.
- Keep products in their original containers. Do not switch harmful medicines or household products to familiar food or drink containers.
- Anticipate your child's development in advance. Keep harmful medicines and household products out of reach and in locked cabinets.
- Never call medicine candy. Do not take medicine in front of a child, because they love to imitate. Know the correct dose of every medicine you give and read labels carefully.
- Many poisonings occur when a parent or caregiver is using a harmful product. If you're using a harmful product and the doorbell or phone rings or other distractions demand your attention, do not leave the product unattended — take it with you.
- Know the botanical or common name of your household plants, so you will be able to tell the Poison Control Center the correct name if a child eats any part of it.
- Vitamins with iron, cosmetics, perfumes, cigarettes, alcohol and many over-the-counter drugs are potential problems. Keep all of these products locked up.
- When having visitors, be sure to place their handbags and backpacks up high where your child won't be able to reach them. Children can reach into bags and pull out items such as medicines, pills and lipstick.
- Remember that children are attracted to products in the same way that adults are. If a container is pretty or a bright color or the contents smell good, there is a greater chance that the child will be curious about it. ([uscfbenioffchildrens.org](http://uscfbenioffchildrens.org))
- Know how to properly dispose of old, unneeded prescriptions. They can be flushed down the toilet, added to kitty litter or soil with water and put in trash or taken to the special receptacle in the lobby of the Lapeer County Jail.

## Poison Prevention

*"O Lord, my God, by day I cry out; at night I clamor in your presence. Let my prayer come before you; incline your ear to my call for help..." Psalm 87:2-3*

Accidental poisoning is a surprisingly common problem in the United States. We all play a role in preventing accidental poisoning. "In 2020, the 55 U.S. Poison Control Centers provided telephone guidance for over 2.1 million human poison exposures. That's about: one poison exposure reported to U.S. Poison Control Centers every 15 seconds." ([poison.org](http://poison.org)) According to the Health Resources and Services Administration's Poison Help Project, 51% of poisoning exposures occur in children under age six.

The CDC defines "poisoning as any substance that is harmful to your body when ingested (swallowed), inhaled, injected or absorbed through the skin." The most common types of poisoning are: medications, household products and pesticides, Carbon Monoxide, household plants, alcohol, nicotine or illicit substances, Hydrocarbons (gasoline, kerosene, lighter fluid, paint remover and motor oil), batteries, and personal care products. The USCF Benioff Children's Hospital offers several suggestions for preventing poisoning in children.

To get help in an emergency you can call 911 for guidance, call the National Poison Control Center or use their web app or go to the ER. By calling the National Poison Control Center hotline at 1-800-222-1222 you can get immediate help. This phone number is routed to the poison center designated to serve your region.

You can also use the webPOISONCONTROL tool to get specific guidance for your case, based on age & weight of person, substance& amount taken.

The webPOISONCONTROL tool is online at [poison.org](http://poison.org) or can be downloaded for free from the App Store or Google play store. Do not hesitate to contact poison control or emergency personal if you think a poisoning has occurred — you may save a life!
