

Lots of Legion of Mary Ministries!

It was last June that we started the Legion of Mary group here at St. Mary of the Assumption Parish. This group is supposed to help the pastor of a parish to minister to those in the parish and the community. I can honestly say that the group has helped me immensely in reaching out to others. We have accomplished many things in a short time (about 8 months).

The Legion of Mary consists of a weekly meeting that includes praying the rosary together and accomplishing 2 hours of apostolic work each week. We do our best to go out two by two to encourage each other in the ministry. We ask for the strength of Our Blessed Mary to guide us in our ministries and to ask the Holy Spirit to energize us to go out and spread the Good News!

Here is a rundown of the ministries we have done in our brief history: Visiting area nursing homes many times— Van Crest (Van Wert and Delphos), Van Wert Manor, Homestead, and Hearth and Home. In these nursing homes, we have talked to people, brought them the Eucharist, had prayer services including music and singing-hoping that the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary could help us to express to them that they are loved. We do not limit our visits to just Catholics but reach out to anyone in need.

The Legion of Mary has also visited the homebound (and brought them food), hospitals, the bereaved-which included attending wake services, praying the rosary, and helping at funeral dinners, visited a former parishioner at Otterbein in St Marys. We have organized the praying of the rosary 6 times for Our Lady of Fatima. We have prayed 2 Patriotic rosaries and will do more in the future. We passed out 102 Miraculous Medals the first weekend of Advent. Someone drove a homebound parishioner to Sunday Mass.

Still other ministries included having a fair booth, helping out at a food pantry, and for the Salvation Army. There was also helping out at Bread and Bowl and Trunk or Treat. In addition, there were weekly AA meetings, Song Fest and even noodle making. As you can see, we accomplished quite a big share of ministries to the beautiful children of God.

The Legion of Mary meets every Thursday at 2 p.m. in the Holy Family Room in the basement of the rectory. If any of you want to stop by and see what our meetings are like, feel free to attend. If you want to help us in this ministry but find it difficult to attend all the meetings, you can become an auxiliary member. An auxiliary member prays the rosary along with some Legion of Mary prayers every day to help keep this ministry strong. And you only need to attend one meeting a year. 


