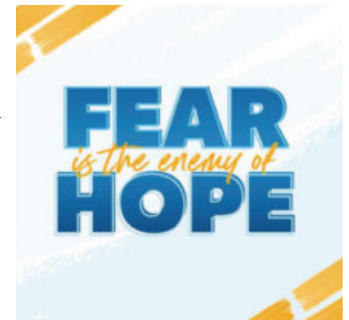


We'll be honoring the high school graduates of 2022 during the **11:30am Mass on Sunday, June 5**, followed by a brunch reception in the parish hall.

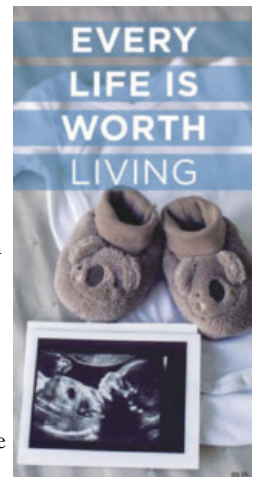


Stop the Abortion Amendment!

Help spread the word about why **people should NOT sign the Reproductive Freedom for All Petition**. A petition drive (**Reproductive Freedom for All**) has started, sponsored by Planned Parenthood and the ACLU, to get a constitutional amendment for an unlimited right to abortion on the November ballot. See the table in the Narthex for more information.

This amendment would repeal dozens of state laws, including our state's ban on tax-funded abortions, the partial-birth abortion ban, and fundamentally alter the parent-child relationship by preventing parents from having input on their children's health. The petition drive is also **an attempt to invalidate the state's long-standing ban on abortion**, which is poised to become effective again, if or when the U.S. Supreme Court overturns *Roe v. Wade*.

This amendment is **opposed** by the Michigan Catholic Conference, the official voice of the Catholic Church in Michigan on public policy.

As you led your brother, St. Peter, to Christ and many others after him, draw us also to Him.

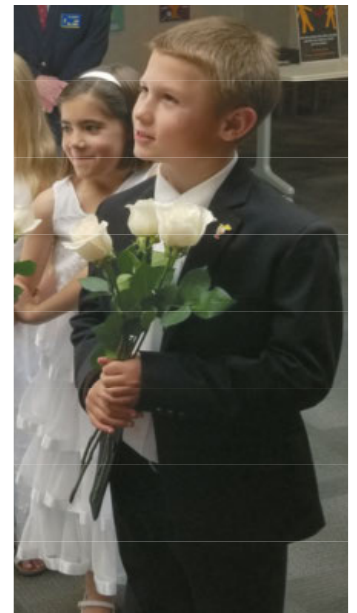
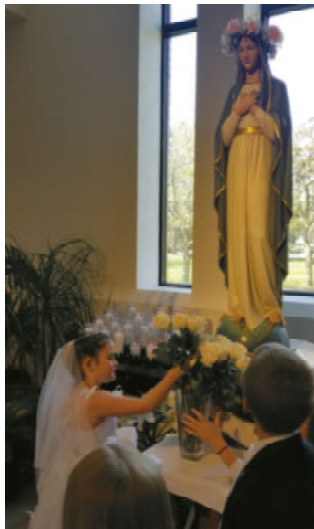
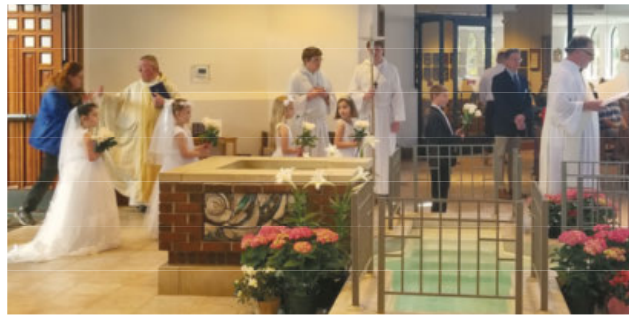
Teach us to lead others to Christ solely out of love for Him and dedication in His service.

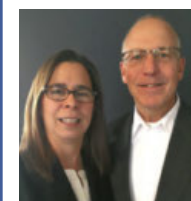
