
St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church




Our Prayer to St. Andrew







Stop the Abortion Amendment!

Help spread the word about why **people should NOT sign the**Reproductive Freedom for All Petition. A petition drive
(Reproductive Freedom for All) has started, sponsored by Planned
Parenthood and the ACLU, to get a constitutional amendment for an
unlimited right to abortion on the November ballot. See the table in
the Narthex for more information.

This amendment would repeal dozens of state laws, including our state's ban on tax-funded abortions, the partial-birth abortion ban, and fundamentally alter the parent-child relationship by preventing parents from having input on their children's health. The petition drive is also an attempt to invalidate the state's long-standing ban on abortion, which is poised to become effective again, if or when the U.S. Supreme Court overturns Roe v. Wade.

This amendment is **opposed** by the Michigan Catholic Conference, the official voice of the Catholic Church in Michigan on public policy.
