
St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church



Dear Friends,

Once again, The Lingap Children's Foundation was honored to be included in St. Andrew's annual Lenten 'Operation Outreach' program, along with **Children Waiting Everywhere** for schools in Kenya, Uganda and Sri Lanka, **St. Mary's Boy's School and Child Rescue Center** in Kenya and **Tim's Clinic** in Nicaragua. I was literally astounded once again this year, to learn that you raised a total of \$13,550 for each of the four organizations!! This is beyond fantastic. I wish I could effectively express how much this means to us.

As you all know so well, the past two years have been more than challenging for everyone, everywhere around the world - including for the Lingap kids in the Philippines, due to COVID. Then, on December 16, just prior to Christmas, a horrific typhoon named 'Odette,' slammed the island of Cebu, including the Lingap Center. Clearly God had His hands over the Lingap Center as we had little damage and no one was injured. But the surrounding community was clearly not as fortunate.

In early April, I was *finally* able to visit the Philippines for the first time since it all began! I am very happy to report that things were actually quite a bit better (*for us*) than I had anticipated. The biggest issue was and continues to be with regard to education. The typhoon totally destroyed one of the schools our kids attend (*including their academic records*) and seriously damaged some of the other schools. However, due to COVID, there has been no 'in person'



education since the pandemic began. While remote learning works well here in the U.S., it is not really effective in a country where neither the teachers or the students have access to computers. (We continue to thank God every day that thanks to our supporters, we do have a good computer lab at the Lingap Center). We are VERY hopeful that the schools will open next year, but we will have to wait and see. Thus far, the DepEd has not given us any guidance. The Lingap staff has been absolutely incredible in their efforts to continue the education process, in spite of almost insurmountable difficulties.

The support that you have all provided to us through Operation Outreach is huge to us. It will make a tremendous difference in our ability to continue to help some of the least fortunate children in the world! Please keep in mind that none of what we have been able to accomplish thus far for the kids, would have been possible without the help of people like you.

Through your support, you have literally put out your hands and you have touched the lives of a lot of really great kids in many places around the world. There is no way that I can ever thank you enough!


Our Prayer to St. Andrew
