PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

Skunked! Gus, the rectory dog, chased a skunk this morning (at a quarter after five, thank you), and the skunk did what skunks do. Some words were said. With a larger dog who doesn't want to be bathed, there is a thin line between a bath and a wrestling match. Needless to say, my day isn't going the way I expected when I went to bed last night. Sometimes that's how it works. Life throws you a curveball. In the spectrum of possible curveballs, it could be worse than a skunked dog. From the simple to the life altering, a lot of life turns on how we handle the unexpected. Sometimes

it's the relative or friend who turns up without warning, or the neighbor who needs a favor in a pinch. Sometimes it's the surprise diagnosis or unplanned pregnancy.

How we handle life's curveballs can change everything. When we respond with practiced generosity to one who asks for help, or receive the one in need with patience and compassion, we reflect the attitude of Christ, who received those along the way with a healing hand and a word of forgiveness. When we bear life's burdens with grace and peace, we exercise faith in God's providence and love. Sometimes it is the event we didn't expect that shows our true temperament and attitude. The thing that tries my patience or tests my charity is a good measure of who I am within. The ancient Greeks called this habit, either for good or bad (virtue of vice). Simply put, what do I do when I don't have time to steer my actions. The best way to develop habits for good is to look for opportunities to practice doing good works and so train myself to reflexively move that way, like an athlete trains the muscles to move without thinking about it, or a craftsman or artist trains his or her hand and eye to work instinctively.

God gives us each day, both the expected and the unexpected, to grow in his sight and flourish. May He help us use each day well and rejoice in the possibilities it brings.
