

PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

Fall weather has arrived and fall colors won't be far behind. As nature's fireworks work their way down the mitten, all of the beloved fall traditions are in full swing. Our Football team will play their final game of the season this Saturday, and our girls' volleyball team is on a run, at the head of the South Central League! Our St. Philip students have also passed the half-way mark in the fall semester.

In previous columns I have written about the Church's observances in October, namely the month of the rosary and the right to life, especially the defense of the innocent and defenseless unborn and the witness to the scourge of abortion. Looking around in your neighborhood, you will likely see other observances in October. It has become more and more popular to decorate yards for Halloween, sometimes beginning as early as labor day. Many of these displays are fun and imaginative, but some also go overboard or go in a very dark direction.

There is a healthy Catholic habit of poking at death and remembering that for the one who hopes in Christ, at death, life is changed, not ended, and that the dead who have died in Christ shall rise again. On the other side of things, an unhealthy fascination with death and the macabre can be an avenue for trouble. We should remember that there is an enemy, the Devil and his fallen angels, who "prowl about the world, seeking the ruin of souls". An excessive lingering in dark thoughts and dark places can be an invitation to trouble.

The Christian should be wary of this in themes of gore that cheapen the regard for life, in movies or books that shock for the sake of shocking, in art or music that lingers on darkness, anger, and wrath. These things have a way of turning the mind and the heart and instilling a troubled spirit. Especially troubling is the trend to dark and ghoulish themes in children's entertainment. Too many parents still have a naive attitude that if a particular program or film is marketed to children, that it is safe for their consumption. In this, Christians should certainly not be involved in games that draw the player into occult or dark themes. Especially troublesome and certain card games that play on superstition and the ouija board, which should never be allowed in a Catholic home. If you call out, there is every chance that the spirit you invite may bring trouble.

The alternative is a healthy attention to our own mortality and the hope we have of life in Jesus Christ. The month of October began with the feast of the guardian angels, and we should call on them often in the course of our day for help and protection. If you suspect there is some diabolical activity afoot, the best first response is the recourse to Grace God promises every day. The rosary is a powerful prayer in this regard, and most exorcists will tell you a good confession and Holy Communion devoutly received is as potent as anything in his tool box. The two great mistakes we may make in regard to the Devil and his fallen angels are these: to deny their existence and to be fascinated with their existence. The better road is to give the Devil his due and no more. After all, as St. Paul says, "greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world!"




time, please do not leave it in church but give it to an usher or return it to the parish office. Thank you for your support.
