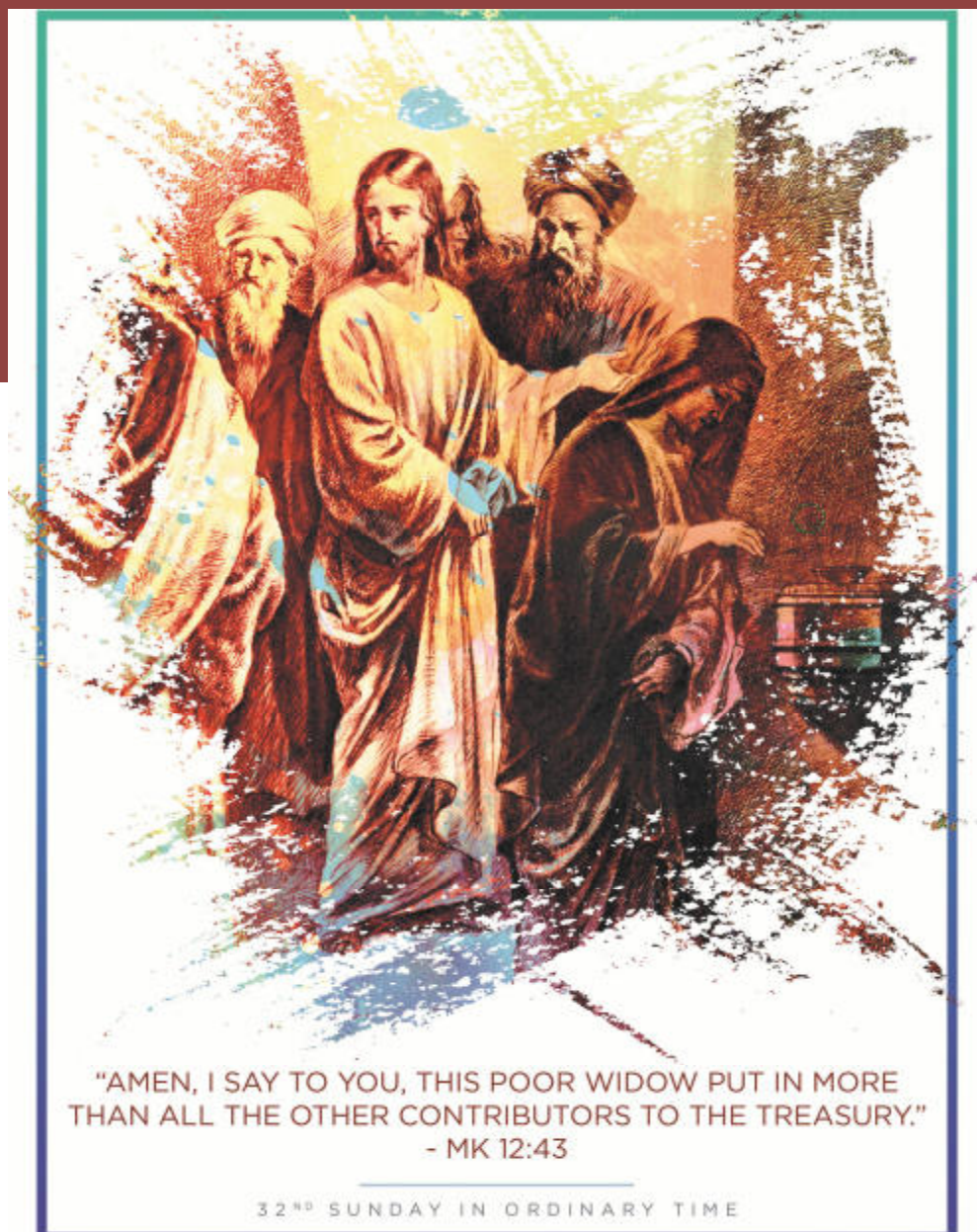

PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

As we begin the month of November, we come into the home stretch of the Church year. The new liturgical year begins with the season of Advent, which this year begins the Sunday after Thanksgiving. At the end of the liturgical year, the Church looks to the last things. Each year represents all time in micro, and points us to the end of time and the life of the world to come.

Because of this, the Church devotes November to those departed from this world, as we one

day will too. We remember on November 1st the blessed in heaven. The saints have been washed in the blood of Christ, the lamb, and been made pure. They enjoy forever the vision of God in heaven and await the resurrection at the end of time. November 2nd in the feast of All Souls, when we are mindful of those who have died and are in need of our prayers. The witness of the Scriptures teaches us that nothing imperfect can enter the presence of God. The witness of life teaches us that sin bears down on every man and woman and that our hearts are too easily attached to things that are not good for us and keep us from rising to holiness in this life.

Our faith teaches us that those who pass from this world in the love of God, although not yet perfected in love, are called by God's mercy to himself. The difference between the imperfection of a soul passing from this life and the perfection of the soul in heaven is the project of purgatory. In purgatory, by the cleansing fire of divine love, all that remains of the weight of sin is burned away. The soul cleansed this way and prepared for heaven is comforted by the hope of heaven to which he or she moves, and by the prayers of the faithful on earth, you and me.

Our prayers for our loved ones are a great blessing on the souls last pilgrimage and a positive work of charity that we may perform and be brought closer to Christ ourselves. After all, Jesus said, as you did this to the least of my brethren, you did it for me. To encourage this work of mercy, the Church, from the treasury of grace entrusted to her, grants an indulgence that may be gained on behalf of the faithful departed by visiting a cemetery or a church and praying for the dead on any day in November. Additionally, one wishing to gain a plenary indulgence must have detachment from all sin, even venial, make a sacramental confession, receive Holy Communion and pray for the intentions of the pope.

May we be generous in our love of those who have passed from this life, and may we, on our passing, know the generosity and blessing of Christian charity.

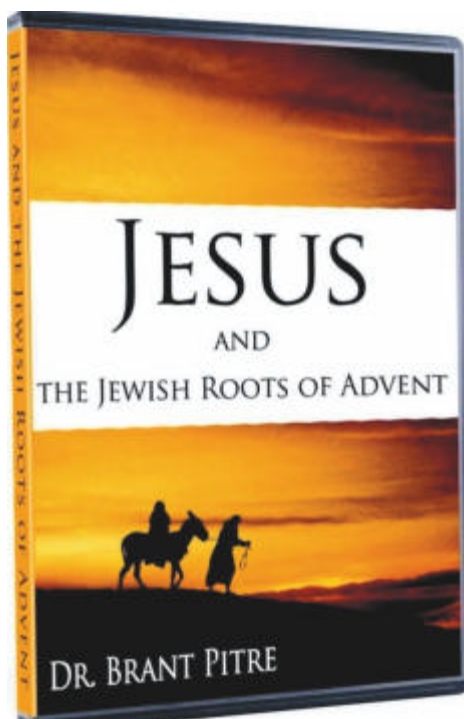

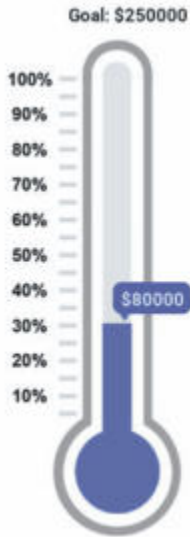
