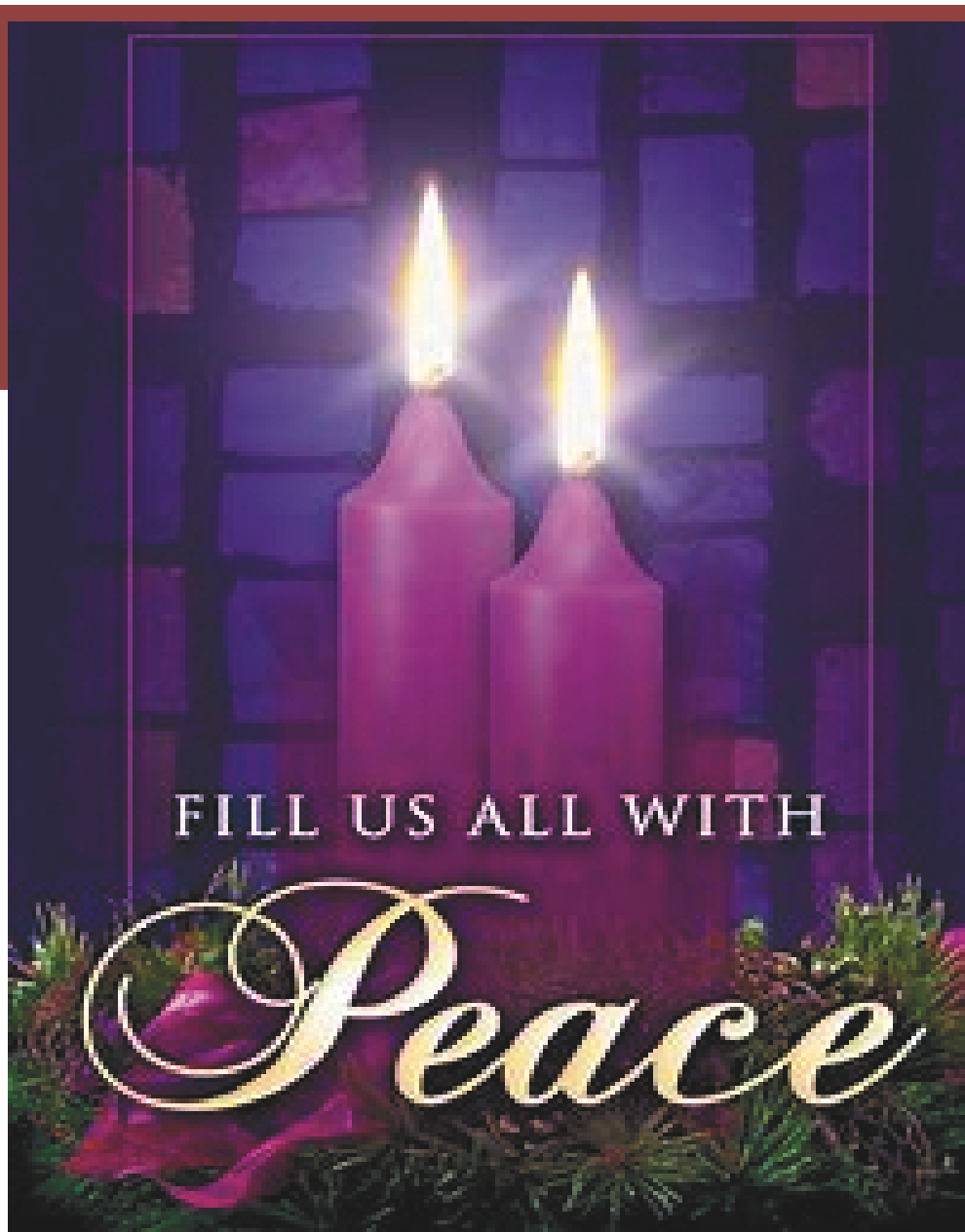

PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

As we come to the second Sunday of Advent, we are well on our way to the celebration of the birth of Jesus at Christmas. On the way there, the Church looks to the coming of Jesus at the end of time in the first few weeks of Advent. After the third Sunday, we turn the corner towards Christmas.

In the bulletin last week, there was an insert with times and days for the special observances of Advent. Two special events are a candlelight Mass and breakfast next Saturday morning, December 11, and a night of Advent and Christmas carols in the parish center, Sunday December 19. Please make time to

participate in the opportunities to get in the Christmas spirit.

I often get asked questions about various aspects of our parish life, and this seems a good time to update you on some ongoing parish projects and concerns.

The sound system in the church is a frequent topic. We have contacted a specialist to assess our sound system and perform some "tune ups". This involves adjusting the current settings, which you may have noticed recently, and some equipment upgrades which should happen in the coming months. Much of this is dependent on the supply chain issues we are all experiencing.

The livestreaming of Masses has been a help to many parishioners who are home-bound or away from St. Philip. The stream for Sunday 9:00 Masses can be accessed through the St. Philip website or Facebook page. Recently, there have been concerns about the audio quality in the livestream. Several months ago, we had a break in over night and some of the equipment for the livestream was taken. Because of this, we have not been able to connect to the church sound system, but have had to rely on the microphone on the smartphone used for the stream. We are working on replacing this equipment, and should see an improvement in the quality of the audio soon.

You may have noticed the lot at the corner of Division and VanBuren is turned up. We had plans to build a garage for our maintenance needs, allowing work to proceed on the Tiger Room renovation and food incubator project. We have been informed by the city of Battle Creek that our building does not meet the new zoning for the Division corridor, and have been working with the city to identify a mutually satisfactory location and building design for this project. We hope work will begin again in early spring.

Lastly, I have been meeting with an engineer specializing in heating and air-conditioning systems to develop a plan to update the heating systems for the church and school. This new design will integrate cooling as well. I anticipate having the engineering and mechanical design phase of the project early in the new year, at which point we will develop a plan to raise funds for the project and get the needed approvals to begin work. It is my hope that the new heating system could be online for use next winter, with the cooling equipment installed for summer 2023.

Thank you for your ongoing support of our parish community, without which none of these things would be possible.

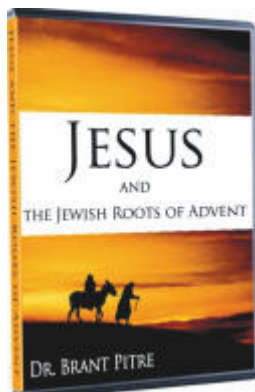

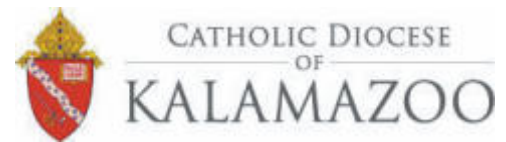
