PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

We are better than halfway on our Advent pilgrimage. This third Sunday of Advent, the Church brightens up with joyful rose colors to remind us of the joyful cause of our Advent preparations. Hopefully you and your families have spent some time this Advent reflecting on the coming of Christ in the flesh, in time in the stable at Bethlehem, and at the end of time in His second coming in the last judgement.

This week our Battle Creek parishes will have a communal penance service on Tuesday evening. One of the gifts the Lord Jesus gave the Church is the Sacrament of Penance, or Reconciliation, for the forgiveness of sins. In Sacramental Confession, the faithful have the confidence of Jesus' forgiveness through the ministry of His priests. The apostles taught that Christians who had committed serious sin must confess those sins to a priest and receive absolution from him to approach the Holy Eucharist.

Catholics are required to make a Sacramental Confession at least once a year, usually during the Easter Season. For those of us who sin more than once a year, more frequent Confession is a good idea. Many spiritual authors recommend frequent Confession, monthly, or even weekly for those trying to overcome particular or habitual sins. Christian life is a path of ongoing conversion, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a vital help on this path. Here God forgives our sins, promises help in overcoming sin, and helps us to see His will more clearly and follow Him more faithfully.

If it has been a while since you have been to Confession, consider this your invitation!

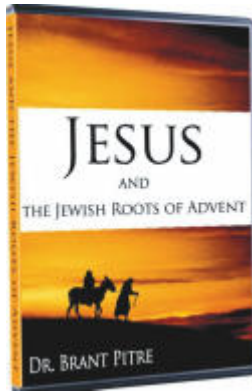

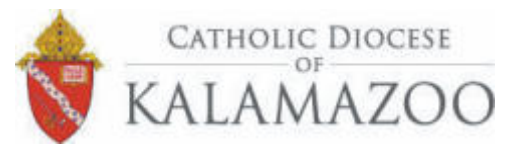


