PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

Merry and blessed Christmas to you and your families! At last we have come once more to the great celebration of the birth of our Savior. All of the longing of the ages is answered in this event, that the eternal Son of God was born of the Virgin Mary in the stable at Bethlehem. By His coming into the world, all humanity sees the full measure of the Love of God and hears the call to rejoice in the One who has come to set His people free from sin and death and bring us to eternal life in Him.

The Church professes to the world today that in the child of Bethlehem, God reveals Himself most fully, and shows us also what it means to be most human. The gift of the Christ child begins in this revelation. 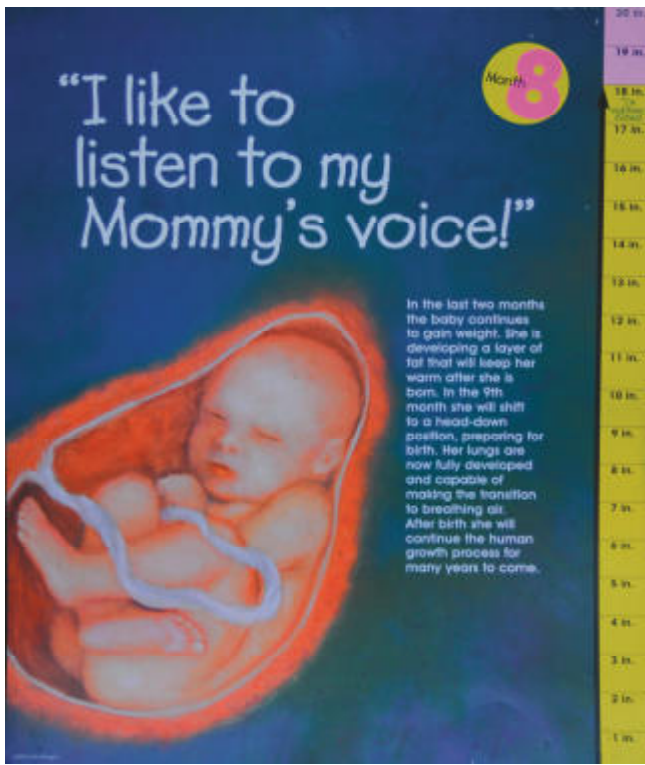

Please join the Tri-Parish Pro-Life Ministry for their annual prayer service that commemorates the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision. Fr. Chris Ankley will lead us in prayer for the unborn at St. Joseph Church. Please join us, on this the 48th anniversary of the legalization of abortion, to pray that our current Supreme Court will overturn this decision that has allowed the killing of more than 60 million babies in this country.
