PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

Happy New Year! A Saturday Christmas makes for a crowded twelve days of Christmas. Typically, the second day of Christmas is celebrated as the feast of the first martyr, St. Stephen. This year, St. Stephen's day is surpassed by the Sunday after Christmas, which is kept as the feast of the Holy Family. This feast celebrating the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph (JMJ), was introduced to the general Roman calendar in 1921. Originally the feast of the Holy Family came later, after the feast of the Epiphany, but was moved to the Sunday after Christmas in the reforms of the calendar following the Second Vatican Council.

The week after Christmas is one of the few remaining octaves left in the calendar, where the celebration of the major feasts is extended for eight days. In the Octave we celebrate the feast of St. John the Evangelist (Dec. 27) and the Holy Innocents (Dec. 28). The eighth day of Christmas, January 1, is the Feast of Mary, Mother of God. The title of Mother of God is given to Mary to recognize that the child she bore is truly God among us from the first moment of His conception. Historically this day was celebrated as the feast of the circumcision of Jesus, when on the eighth day after His birth, He was circumcised according to the covenant of Abraham.

The feast of the Epiphany celebrated the Magi from the East who came to adore the newborn King of the Jews. In the United States, the feast of the Epiphany is celebrated on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. Traditionally, the Epiphany is celebrated January 6, and the vigil of the Epiphany, January 5, is the twelfth day of Christmas, and marks the official end of the Christmas celebrations. Many Catholic cultures extend parts of the Christmas celebration, especially keeping up the Nativity scenes, until the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the temple on February 2.

However you celebrate it, I pray that the blessings of this season and its many joyful observances enrich your homes and bring joy to your families.

May you and your be richly blessed in this New Year of Grace

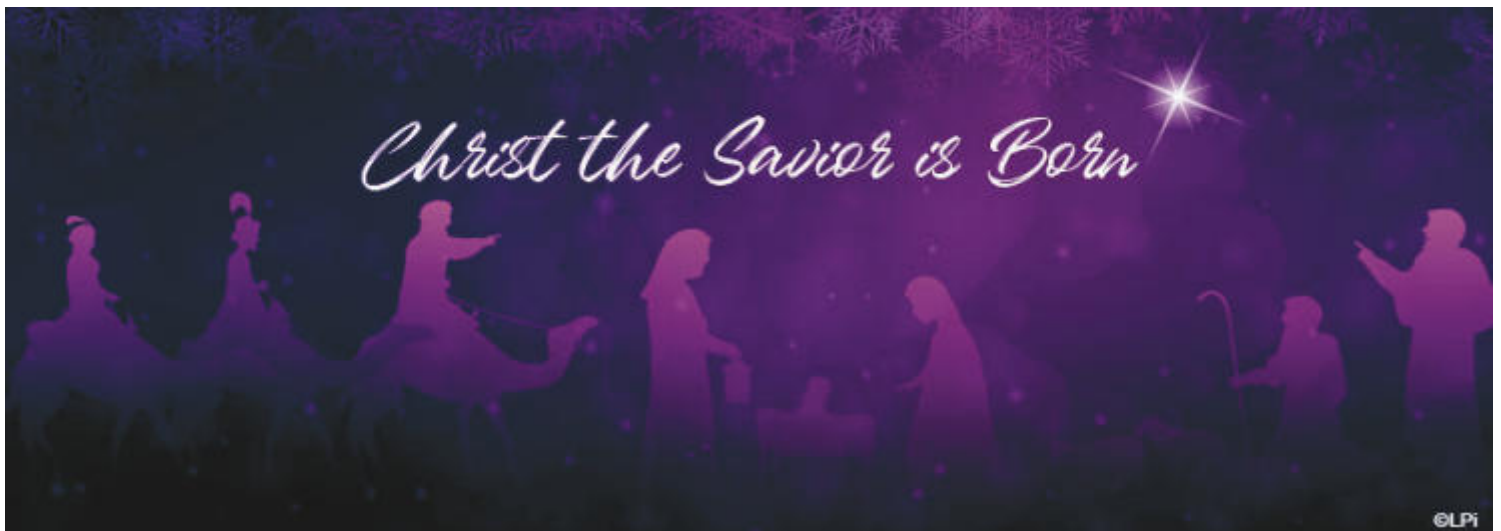

SANCTITY OF LIFE SUNDAY PRAYER SERVICE AND "ROE V. WADE" FILM

Please join the Tri-Parish Pro-Life Ministry for their annual prayer service that commemorates the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision. Fr. Chris Ankley will lead us in prayer for the unborn at St. Joseph Church. Please join us, on this the 48th anniversary of the legalization of abortion, to pray that our current Supreme Court will overturn this decision that has allowed the killing of more than 60 million babies in this country. Afterwards, the film "Roe V. Wade" will be shown in the school cafeteria. This is a docudrama (112 minutes long) that was released in April 2021 directed by and starring Nick Loeb. It also stars John Voight, Stacy Dash, Corbin Bernsen, John Schneider, and Joey Lawrence among others. 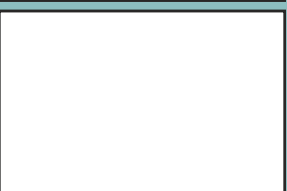
