There will be no Latin Masses for the week of February 21-25

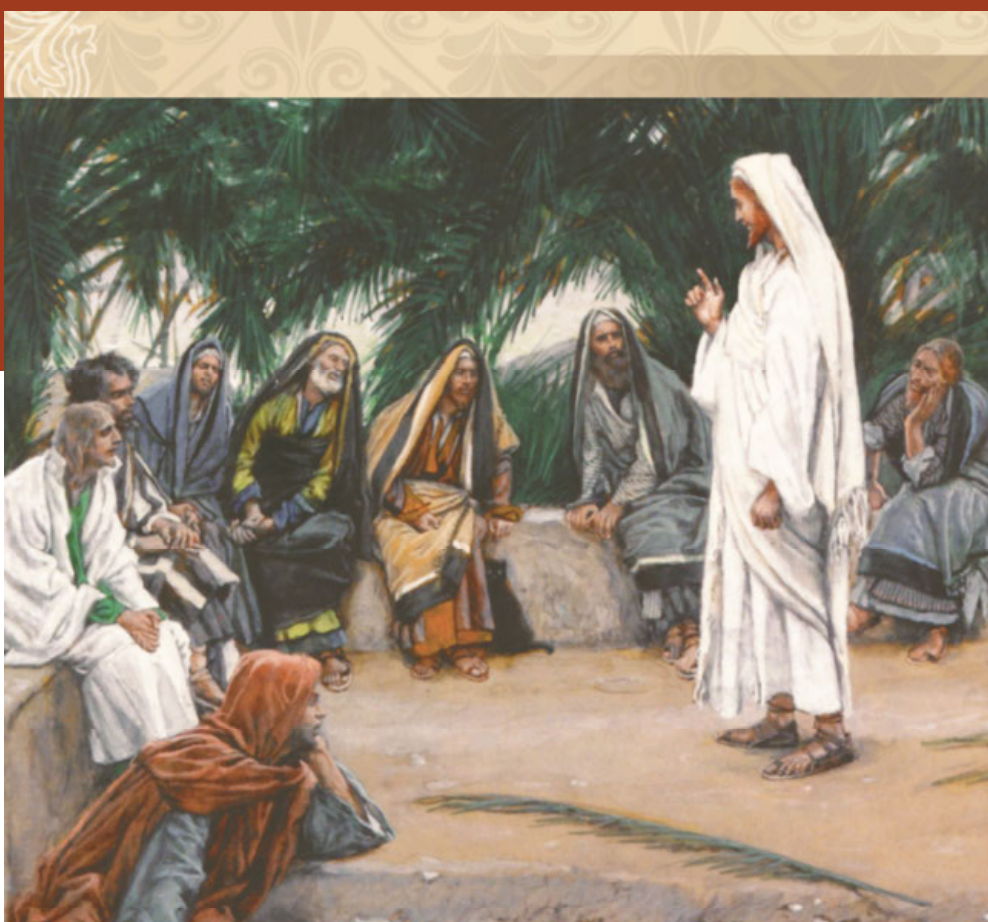

## PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

As Catholics, and in fact as people, we live by habit and traditions. We tend to order our days by routines and many things we do unaware. When I get up in the morning, I have a routine that I follow, especially before the first cup of coffee. These things we do by habit quietly form our attitudes and outlook on life. Often looking at the things we do by habit and examining the meaning and purpose of our actions helps us learn from this repetition and grow. The greatest of these routines or rituals we follow as Christians is the Mass.

Many of us grew up going to Mass every Sunday and learned what to do when and what to say, but haven't spent much time learning why we do these things, or what they mean. For starters, did you know there are 24 different "churches" in the Catholic Church? This refers to the different families of expression of the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic faith which are present around the world. Did you know there are six "rites" or ways of expressing that faith in the liturgies of the church that trace back to the time of the Apostles? These include the Latin rite, Syrian rites (East or Chaldean and West or Antiochene), Byzantine (Greek), and Aleandrian (Coptic or Egyptian). Of these, the one we know as Roman Catholic (the Latin Rite) is one of the most common. What's more, in two thousand years, our own Latin, or Roman, rite has had different variations in different places. The Mass celebrated in medieval England, for instance, was related to the order of Mass in Milan, or Cordoba, or Paris, as part of the Roman Rite, but varied in significant ways.

All of these different ways of celebrating the Eucharistic Liturgy, or Mass, have similar outlines, even though they vary significantly. The basic format of the Liturgy comes to us from two principal sources. From the earliest times, the followers of Jesus gathered to offer the worship of God which Jesus had taught them, which makes present in an unbloody way the offering He made in the upper room at the Last Supper, consummate on the Cross, and gave in His Resurrection. This pattern fulfills the instruction and worship which was present in the synagogue tradition of the Pharisees, and the sacrificial tradition of the temple. In the Mass, the synagogue and the temple meet.

Every rite of the Church, in its own way brings us to this great tradition and joins us in the timeless worship of the new covenant, by which we are joined to the Christ in His Church and renewed in the promise of eternal life which the Gospel promises to those who believe in Him. The Mass, then, is the great gathering of the Body of Christ that is the Church, and is the work by which we are built up in Him. This is why, as Catholics, we put such an emphasis on the Sunday Mass as necessary for the Christian life. If you have been following along by habit, maybe now is a good time to refresh your appreciation for this central Christian act, and if you have not been following along, now is definitely the time to come back to Mass and find out what you've been missing!
