PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear friends of St. Philip,

One of the more peculiar feasts of the Church year happens at the end of February. February 22 is celebrated as the feast of the Chair of St. Peter. The historical record shows this feast celebrated at Rome as early as the beginning of the fourth century. In the ancient world, a teacher sat upon his chair to teach, a sign of his authority.

In the Gospel of Matthew 23:2, Jesus refers to the chair of Moses, upon which the Scribes and Pharisees sit to interpret the law. Indeed, in the book of Exodus, Moses sat upon his seat to judge the people from morning until evening. This act, or office, of judging was at the service of the people. In the biblical model, the role of judgment is first to sort right from wrong, to discern what is true. In Moses time, he shared this work with the elders of Israel,

cern what is true. In Moses time, he shared this work with the elders of Israel, "in their thousands, hundreds, fifties, and tens." The hardest of the cases, he reserved to himself.

Something like this is at work in the Church. In Peter, the prince of the Apostles, the authority to shepherd the Church rests. Following the pattern of the biblical teachers and judges, the bishops, on the most important liturgical occasions, sit on their cathedra teach. (The cathedra is the chair of the bishop for which the cathedral is named.) At Rome, the Pope, who is the successor of St. Peter sits to teach, not just because of old age, but as a living connection with this tradition.

The feast of the Chair of St. Peter is celebrated February 22 because this was thought to be the day on which Simon Peter makes his famous profession of Jesus as the anointed one of God. Jesus, walking along, asks His disciples who people say that He is. They give various answers after which He asks them: 'who do you say that I am?' Simon, speaking for the twelve, says: 'You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.' Jesus calls Peter blessed because of this and following says: 'you are Peter, and upon this rock, I will build My Church...' (Mt 16:13ff)

Peter's confession of Jesus is the foundation of Peter's call as the head of the Apostles and is the Pope's first job as head of the bishops of the Church. To profess Jesus Christ and announce His gospel before the world is the first and greatest work of the successors of Peter. Every one who sits on that chair speaks with this calling. In two thousand years, there have been greater and lesser, holier and more corrupt, popes, but all of them share this calling, and by this measure are accounted good or bad.

This calling is a daunting task before the ebb and flow of the world. This is why we should pray daily for the Pope.
