PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

Lent is a grace filled time to embrace the call to ongoing conversion and be renewed in heart and mind. While the work of conversion is a life-long, every day journey, this special season gives us the chance to focus more deliberately on those habits, whether in action of in thought, or simply the disposition of my heart, that stray from God's plan, and to grow in those habits that fit the life of a disciple of Jesus Christ.

A lot of us will give up some comforts or self-indulgences to grow the ability to say no to the temptation of the moment and bear with the difficulties that come in choosing what is good above what promises comfort or pleasure in the moment. This self-denial helps me to grow in the strength to choose what I know to be good when it may not be what I want.

Extra time in prayer and spiritual reading too can help in the conversion of mind that fits a follower of Jesus. My thoughts guide my actions and form my affections. Time in reading the Bible, lives of the saints, or books of instruction like the Catechism or books about Christian teaching help me to understand the teaching of God as He has revealed it and as it can be lived out every day.

The works of mercy and of compassion in service of our neighbor, whether they be next door or across the world, helps us to grow in affection for God and to grow closer to Jesus. In St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus instructs his disciples, "as you did this for the least of my brothers, you did it for me..." (Mt 25: 31ff). This way of coming close to the Lord is especially privileged, and is at the heart of the life of holiness to which all followers of Jesus are called. In fact this is so important that here Jesus makes these works of mercy the standard of judgment by which one either enters the kingdom or passes to eternal punishment. It seems right that if we do not care to welcome Jesus in the poor and outcast, we would not care to spend eternity in His presence any more. Likewise, if we disdain participating in the healing and merciful work of Jesus in this life, it would be absurd to suppose that we would suddenly, at the hour of our judgment, want to participate in His life in Heaven.

This Lent is a privileged time to draw near to the Lord by fasting, prayer, and sacrificial love. It is not too late to start in earnest or renew our commitment to follow this pilgrim way to Easter glory!
