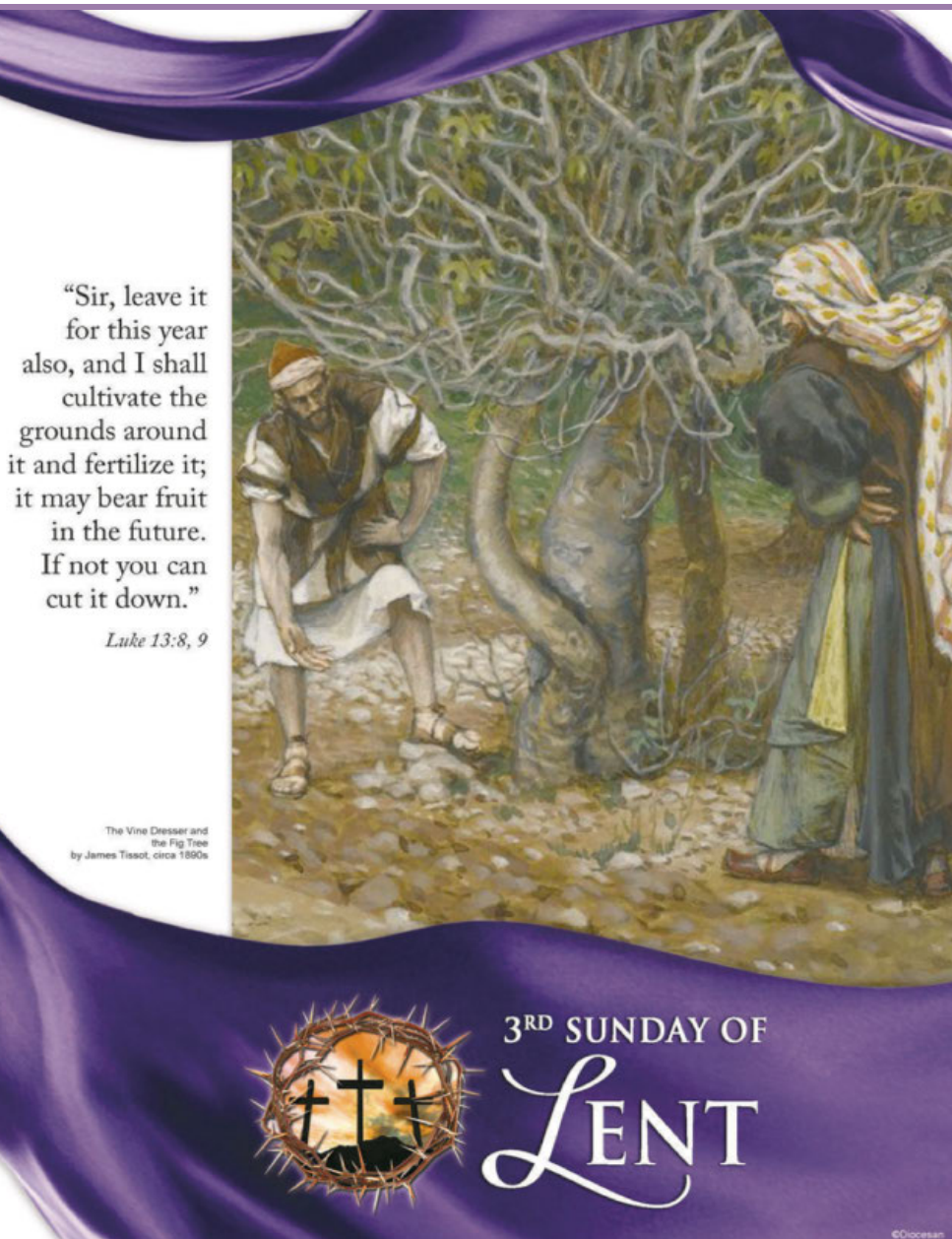

THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Contact the office. In an Emergency, contact the Parish Office and follow the prompts.

MARRIAGE: Registered parishioners should contact the Pastor or Deacons at least six months before the desired date for appropriate marriage preparation instruction.

BAPTISM: Family must be registered at the Parish and attend a preparation class. Contact the Parish Office for information.

RECONCILIATION: 45 minutes before every Mass, lasting for 1/2 hour. Saturday at 3:00pm - 4:00 pm

PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

Lent is a time of preparation for the whole Church, but for some that call is much more immediate and far reaching than most. These people began a journey some time ago that has led them to find their home in the Catholic Church. For those who have not been Baptized, their search has brought them to the place of Catechumens, the ancient Church's title for those requesting the rebirth of sacramental Baptism and incorporation into the Body of Christ. For those already Baptized in

another Church or Christian tradition, they have been accepted as Candidates for full Communion in the Catholic Church. The Catechumens and Candidates will receive the Sacraments of initiation at the Easter vigil.

The journey of conversion and the call of God to be one in the Church is unique to each individual and the Church recognizes the work of the Holy Spirit and the first step that precedes any project or program the parish offers. Each of the people entering the Church this Easter has been on a pilgrimage that has its earthly destination in the Church and its eternal goal in the life of the blessed in Heaven.

Most Catechumens and Candidates spend a considerable amount of time learning about Church doctrines, moral precepts, and prayer life, on their way to asking to join the Church. In Lent, this call to communion and journey into the Church is marked by election of acceptance by the bishop of the diocese at the beginning of Lent. For the Catechumens, there are also rites called Scrutinies that call out all that is weak and sinful through prayers of exorcism and call down upon the Catechumen God's help to strengthen them on the way to Baptism. For the Candidate, the call to ongoing conversion, through which the grace of their Baptism is made fruitful, is heard. For the Catechumens, the ancient practice of handing on the creed of the Church and the Lord's prayer mark this passage toward life in the Church.

At St. Philip, we are blessed to witness several people who are making this journey into the Church and can draw encouragement for our own deepening conversion from the knowledge that God continues to call and attend with His grace those who seek Him with sincere hearts. Let us pray for our Catechumens and Candidates this Lent and pray they know the full joy and blessing of life in His Catholic Church.
