

PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Friends of St. Philip,

As I write this on Tuesday morning, I am preparing to attend the funeral of Fr. Larry Farrell of Kalamazoo. Fr. Farrell was a friend and mentor to me and to many of the priests in Kalamazoo. Many of the people of the diocese may not know who he is because he only had one parish assignment, St. Monica in Kalamazoo, where he was pastor for more than twenty years. He came to priesthood later than most, entering seminary after the loss of his wife.

Like me, he was a transplant from St. Louis, and moved to Kalamazoo when he and his wife were younger. I enjoyed having a fellow transplant to talk to, even relishing the victory of our St. Louis Cardi-

nal over the Detroit Tigers in the World Series in 2006. He brought a wealth of wisdom and experience to his life as a priest and was much loved by the families at St. Monica and around Kalamazoo. He leaves a place that will be hard to fill. He was a trustees advisor to many priests, to the bishop, and to countless lay people.

The passing of a priest is a reminder of the need to pray for our priests, especially in their passing, because the weight of their call and the responsibility they bear in the name of Christ is considerable, as is the grace promised to them. We should also pray for the men whom God is surely calling to the priesthood. There is a lot of competition for a young man's attention these days, and the commitment and sacrifices of the priesthood can be intimidating. The Church needs priests who will answer God's call with courage and determination to serve His flock with all their heart. Pray for these men and encourage them where you see signs of a vocation.

Pray also for me.


