

Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) is designed for those who need extra help to live safely in their home. If someone "55 or better" is struggling physically, with their memory or an unstable health condition, they may be eligible for services through PACE.

PACE model of care is the same, only the faces and stories of those enrolled change. PACE in Michigan is strong with 14 programs. Can you think of a neighbor, church member or loved one who might benefit?

Final determination of measures is based upon the inspection assessment and computer generated report. All services are at no cost to the home owner.

Weatherization measures could include the following: Attic & Wall Insulation, Air Sealing & Caulking, Inspection/ Replacement of Furnace or Water Heater, Weather Stripping, Glass Repair/Replacement, Door Repair/ Replacement, Refrigerator Inspection/Replacement, Smoke & Carbon Detectors, LED Light Bulbs, Minor Plumbing Repair, Minor Roof Repair.




