With the rising cost of food and other necessities, we wanted to share with you some of the various resources in our community that older adults can use to help make ends meet. One resource is MiCafe Network, a program of Elder Law of Michigan. They can help older adults apply for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) (otherwise known as the Bridge Card), assist in applying for the Medicare Savings Program, Extra Help for Medicare Part D, and Medicaid. They can also assist in applying for utility assistance and tax credits.

Their contact number is: 1-877-664-2233 and they are available to assist Monday through Friday 9 AM to 3 PM. You can also contact them online at: micafenetwork.org.

Another way to cut down on food expense is to attend our Community Meal Sites! We have a site in Fremont, Newaygo, and White Cloud. We provide a delicious salad bar, and fresh cooked meals daily. If you are 60 years of age or older, for a suggested donation of \$3 (\$5 fee if under 60), you can get a meal and socialize.

We also want to make you aware of the available food pantries/food banks in our area. Some of these do require income information and registration. Contact the pantry/site directly to get the necessary requirements.







We have started processing applications, but **we are still waiting for most of the coupons to arrive from the State**. Once we receive them, we will be sure to mail them to you as soon as we are able.

In order to qualify for the program, you must be 60 years of age or older and meet the income guidelines. If you haven't received an application yet, please call us at 231-689-2100 to get on the list. Please make sure to sign the application on the **BACK PAGE** once you receive it.

Also, the State has increased the income guidelines for this year! So, you may qualify now!

Updated Income guidelines:

1 person: \$25,142 2 people: \$33,874

One more thing. If you are a couple, both over 60, and your combined income is \$33,874 or less, then you can each get coupons. We will need an application from both of you.
