## OUR SACRAMENTAL POLICY

Six month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

**Baptism:** Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requests that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic, and the Godparents must be practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If there are two godparents, one

must be male, one must be female. If there is one godparent, they may be male or female.

**Marriage:** Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Call the Rectory office. Officiate at the ceremony must be the Parish Pastor, Deacon, or a family member.

**Funerals:** Officiate must be the Parish Pastor of Immaculate Conception, or a family member

Please note: the services of the Parish Organists are used for all Weddings and Funerals.

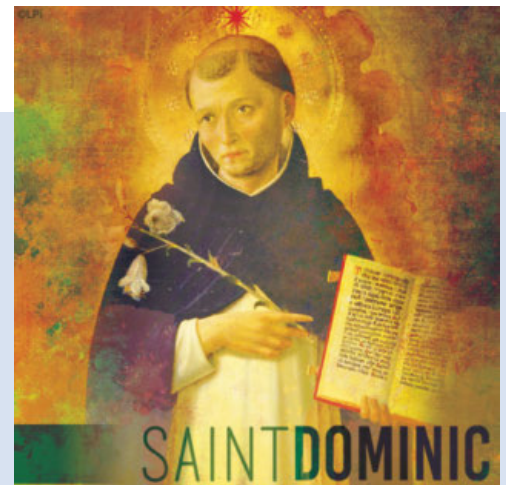

## ASK DEACON JOE

### Is a monk a priest or a brother? And what is a friar?

This is a much more involved question than it first appears.

In general there are three states of life for members of the Church: clergy, religious, and laity.

The clergy consists of men who have been ordained, i.e. they have received the Sacrament of Holy Orders. These are bishops, priests, and deacons.

Religious are men and women who profess the evangelical counsels (counsels of perfection). They take solemn vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience; or no money, no honey, no say. Women religious are called nuns or sisters. Men religious are called monks or friars depending on their religious order. Monks belong to orders such as the Benedictines, Trappists, and Carthusians and focus more on solitude and contemplation. Friars belong to orders such as the Franciscans, Dominicans, and Carmelites and focus more on preaching and public ministry.

Some monks and friars are also ordained to the priesthood and are addressed as father. They are called "order priests" in contrast to the "diocesan priests" who minister at most of our parishes. Order priests usually serve at retreat centers and monasteries. (Diocesan priests do not take a vow of poverty.) Friars and monks who are not ordained are commonly called brothers; friar comes from the French word frère which means brother. So in answer to the first question, a monk can be either a priest or a brother.

## ST. LAWRENCE- AUGUST 10

Little is known about Lawrence other than he was a deacon during the reign of Emperor Valerian from 253–259. In 258, Valerian began a persecution of the Roman Church. Lawrence was in charge of the purse for the Church of Rome. Roman officials demanded that the riches of the church be handed over to them. Lawrence asked for a few days to gather them. Lawrence took the money he had charge over and distributed it to the poor of Rome. Then he gathered all the homeless and poor together. When the officials came again demanding the riches of the church, Lawrence pointed to the destitute and homeless, saying that these were the true riches of the church. For this he was imprisoned and tortured, and put to death by burning on a gridiron. It is said that as he was dying, he told his executioners to turn him over because he was done on one side and needed to be fully cooked for the Lord. Lawrence continues to be a model for us today. The church needs continual reminders that its riches are the people. The primary purpose and mission of the church is to be continually sensitive to the needs of all God's people, most especially the least of our brothers and sisters.
