

What is 2-1-1?

It is a free and confidential information and referral service. Call 2-1-1 for help with food, housing, employment, health care, counseling, and more. GLEAP (Grand Ledge Emergency Assistance Program), an umbrella group that works with area organizations, participates in 2-1-1.

What is a Mass Intention and how do I get one?

It has been a long standing tradition that every Mass celebrated is allowed to have one specific intention for a person or persons, living or deceased. Requesting a Mass intention can be a beautiful way to remember and pray for someone who has died, especially around the time of their birthday or anniversary of their death. It can also be a way to honor someone who is living, including a birthday or anniversary celebration. Mass intentions are published each week in the bulletin. The person(s) being prayed for are included in the prayers of the faithful or at the beginning of Mass.

Traditionally an offering is given when a Mass intention is requested, but it is not required. The standard amount is \$10. All money received for Mass offerings goes to our parish budget.

While there is a bit of a wait for Mass intentions for weekend liturgies, we have numerous openings for intentions for weekday Masses. Please contact our parish office to schedule a Mass.

And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy. And to walk humbly with your God.

According to the 1951 Refugee Convention, a <u>refugee</u> is one who "owing to a well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group or political opinion, is outside the country of his nationality, and is unable to, or owing to such fear, is unwilling to avail himself of the protection of that country." Oftentimes, these individuals have faced threats or experiences of violence and torture.

Refugees are not, however, those who have left their home country for the purpose of seeking a more prosperous life, otherwise known as <u>economic</u> migrants.

World Refugee Day is an international day designated by the United Nations to honor refugees around the globe. It falls each year on <u>June 20</u> and celebrates the strength and courage of people who have been forced to flee their home country to escape conflict or persecution. World Refugee Day is an occasion to build empathy and understanding for their plight and to recognize their resilience in rebuilding their lives.


