### Inquiring about God and Faith?

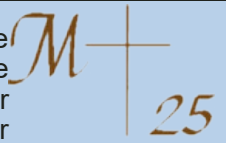


Are you, or is someone you know, asking questions about God, Jesus, faith, religion, Catholicism? We will begin gathering in September to journey with those who would like to explore some answers to
